

Condition/Concern

Some owners may comment on the rear sliding glass being inoperative or noisy when operated. This could be caused by the cable pulley cover becoming separated, see photos below.

If the cable pulley cover completely disengages, the pulley can come off and cause the cable to bind, see photo below.

Note: Do NOT replace the complete back sliding glass assembly for this issue.

Do replace the rear sliding window regulator assembly (GM part number 23175121).
