#### 46 Brake pulsation/thumping - Repair Authorization

#### Condition

- Any of the following conditions are found on a low-mileage MY14 A6 or A7:
  - Customer or technician hears a thumping noise while braking.
  - Customer or technician feels pulsations while braking.
  - There is brake pad residue (also called "pad marks") on the brake discs (Figure 1).



Figure 1. Example of brake discs with brake pad residue.

- These conditions may be found at PDI, or after there are a few hundred miles on the odometer.
- These conditions may exist on the front and/or rear brakes.

## **Technical Background**

In an effort to gain information on these conditions for MY14 A6 and A7 vehicles, we are asking that you contact the Audi Technical Assistance Center (TAC) before replacing any parts. This will assist us in diagnosing any potential issues with the conditions noted above.
