- 2. Update the engine control module (ECM), J623 (address word 01) and the transmission control module (TCM), J217 (address word 02) using the SVM action code listed in the table below.

Criteria 03 and 04: Replacing Coolant Thermostat and Quick Release Coupling

Replace the coolant thermostat and the quick release coupling by following the instructions in ElsaWeb >> Repair Manual >> Engine >> Engine Mechanical >> 19
Cooling System >> Removal and Installation >> Map Controlled Engine Cooling




Figure 1. Coolant thermostat (2).




Figure 2. Quick release coupling (1).

Thermostat -F265- (Figure 1 and Figure 2).

Tip: The quick release coupling is located directly on the coolant thermostat. It is removed together with the coolant thermostat when the coolant thermostat is replaced. However, the coolant thermostat does not have to be removed when the quick release coupling is replaced (Figure 1 and Figure 2).

Criteria 05: Install Protective Grille




Figure 3. Closure plate for bumper cover (3).

1. Remove closure plate for bumper cover (Figure 3)




Figure 4. Fit protective grille onto radiator.




Figure 5. Secure grille with nine retaining clips.

2. Fit protective grille onto radiator (Figure 4) and secure with nine retaining clips (Figure 5).

1. Replace ACF hose (Figure 6 and Figure 7). The hose clip can be re-used.




Figure 8. Hose clip (3).

Criteria 07: Replace Oil Filler Neck




Figure 9. Oil filler neck.

Replace oil filler neck (Figure 9).

Torque bolt to 9 Nm (Figure 10).
