PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Charge Port Door Will Not Open in Cold Weather


Models: 2013 Chevrolet Volt With Part Built Between May Through August 2012 Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on the charge port door not opening in cold weather.

The hinge pin for the charge port door may have been misaligned when assembled. The charge port assembly has a time stamp located on the hinge. DO NOT use any part with a time stamp built between May through August 2012. To verify the charge port assembly time stamp, remove the charge port housing – Refer to the pictures below (Showing a build date of May (1) 2012 (2)).

Recommendation/Instructions

If the charge port door is NOT built within the dates listed above, refer to SI for further diagnosis.

If the charge port door is built within the dates listed above, replace the charger port housing. Refer to Charge Port Housing Replacement in SI.

Note: It is critical that the receptacle is aligned and properly fastened to the charge port door assembly. If not, the door could stick to the misaligned receptacle.
