PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Exterior Paint Rough Finish/Dull Appearance

Models: 2013 Buick Encore
2013 Chevrolet Caprice PPV, Spark

Attention: All involved vehicles are identified by VIN in the Global Warranty Management System – Investigate Vehicle History Application under the Service Information section with reference to this PI number.

Condition/Concern

Some customers or Buick and Chevrolet dealers may comment on a rough and/or dull paint finish condition on the horizontal exterior surfaces of the vehicle. This condition may also appear on the window glass and vehicle exterior trim and lamps.

This condition is most likely a combination of airborne dirt and sea salt, combined with rainfall, that is causing the rough or dull finish condition. As airborne contaminants combine with water, the contaminants are suspended in the water. As the water dries or evaporates, the contaminants are left to adhere to the finish. This process is accelerated by exposure to the sun. The heat from the sun can cause the contaminants to “bond” to the finish.

Washing the car with automatic car washing equipment may not remove these contaminants because the soap solution is not allowed to soak the vehicle long enough to soften and remove the contaminants from the paint.

Recommendation/Instruction

Note: The vehicle should be washed top to bottom with a very clean chamois. Avoid using a sponge, which can hold particulates and cause scratches to the vehicle.

To remove the contaminants, perform this operation on a cool vehicle, in a shaded area (avoid direct sunlight). Thoroughly wet a large towel in hot water and allow it to sit on the contaminated surface for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove the towel and soak the towel in hot water and apply it to the area again. After the second application of the wet towel, thoroughly wash contaminated area with hot water and a high quality car wash soap and a very clean chamois. Keep the surface saturated with hot water and the wash solution using a circular motion.

Note: In extreme cases it may be necessary to apply a 50/50 mixture water and vinegar to the window glass to remove the residue, followed by a thorough rinse with clean water.
