Subject: No Crank/No Start with Key or Starts with Remote Start Then Shuts Off When Key is

Turned to Run Position

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Silverado 1500

2014 GMC Sierra 1500

Condition/Concern

In very rare cases, some customers may comment that the vehicle will not crank or start or that the vehicle will start using the remote start feature then shuts off and will not restart when the key is turned to the RUN position.

Once the BCM goes to sleep (approximately 10 minutes), the vehicle will start and function normally.

When checking the vehicle for DTCs, none will be present. There also will be no warning lights or messages.

Recommendation/Instructions

An updated software calibration has been released to address this concern. Technicians should reprogram the body control module (BCM) using the Service Programming System (SPS) with the latest calibrations available on TIS2WEB. Refer to the Body Control Module Programming and Setup procedure in SI.
