PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Normal Characteristic – Headlamp Haze Appearance When Illuminated

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Corvette
Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that there appears to be a haze on the headlamps when illuminated. This is particularly noticeable at night or in dark places.

Recommendation/Instructions

This is a normal characteristic of the vehicles headlamps and no repair(s) should be attempted for this concern.

All headlamps with a projector will have this haze effect when illuminated due to the light transmission loss caused by natural composition in the lens material itself. It may be slightly more noticeable on the new C7 Corvette due to rake angle of the lens, but you can see this on other vehicles with projectors as well.
