

Glove Compartment Rattle over Rough Roads

Repair Procedure

- 1. Remove the Glove Compartment Door Assembly.
 - A. Disengage the claw and release the glove compartment door stopper sub-assembly.





B. Slightly bend stoppers A and B in the directions indicated by the arrows in the illustration and pull the Glove Compartment Door Assembly until the stoppers are released.

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

Repair Procedure (Continued)

 C. Open the Glove Compartment Door Assembly to approximately 55° from its closed position.
 Pull it horizontally in the direction indicated by the arrow to disengage the 2 hinges and remove it.

NOTICE

Pulling the Glove Compartment Door Assembly upward to remove it causes the hinges to deform. Be sure to pull the door assembly horizontally. / Figure 2.


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Repair Procedure (Continued)

- 2. Install the NEW Glove Compartment Door Assembly.
 - A. With the Glove Compartment Door Assembly opened approximately 55° from its closed position, engage the 2 hinges horizontally.

NOTICE


Engaging the hinges from the top will deform the hinges. Be sure to install the Glove Compartment Door Assembly horizontally. Figure 3.
