Introduction

Some 2012 – 2013 model year Tacoma vehicles may exhibit a wind whistle type noise from the front of the vehicle. This noise may be coming from the radiator grille where it meets the hood. A radiator grille seal has been developed to address this condition.


Repair Procedure

 Confirm the condition as described in the introduction.

HINT

Noise occurs due to a gap between the radiator rubber seal and the radiator grille.

- 2. Duplicate the noise, then mask off the rubber seal between the radiator grille and the hood. Is the noise still present?
 - YES This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
 - NO Continue to step 3.


- 3. Remove the radiator grille.
 - A. Remove the 2 screws.
 - B. Using the plastic pry tool, remove the 2 clips.
 - C. Disengage the 8 guides and remove the radiator grille.

Figure 3. Back View of Radiator Grille





- 5. Separate the radiator inner grille from the outer grille.
 - A. Using a plastic pry tool, remove the 10 claws.


Figure 4. Cross Section View




Figure 7. Front Side of Radiator Grille





Figure 8. Back View of Radiator Grille










Repair Procedure (Continued)

8. Apply the Radiator Grille Seal to the rib and be sure to center the seal sealer so that it overlaps both sides of the rib equally.






Figure 12. Cross Section View


1	Radiator Grille Seal


Figure 14. Back View of Radiator Grille




1 Radiator Grille Outer (Cover)



Screw Location

- 11. Install the radiator grille to vehicle.
 - A. Engage the 8 guides and install the radiator grille.
 - B. Install the 2 clips.
 - C. Tighten the 2 screws.
- 12. Test drive the vehicle and confirm noise is no longer present.
