SERVICE BULLETIN

REASON FOR RELEASE: To ensure the captain's station CO2 fire bottles (safety pin) is not being obstructed due to the close proximity of an appliance.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Examine all Duck CO2 fire bottle (Safety Pins)
2. If pin is obstructed by the stereo amplifier or other, loosen the nut directly under the pull handle and rotate the head so the safety pin is no longer obstructed.
3. If adjustment can not be achieved, relocate the amplifier or other item in-way of safety pin.
4. If Safety Pin can be adjusted, consider moving appliances that would hamper easy removal of the bottle during annual certification and weighing.
5. Notify RTDI Fleet Operations if you need assistance in complying with this bulletin.

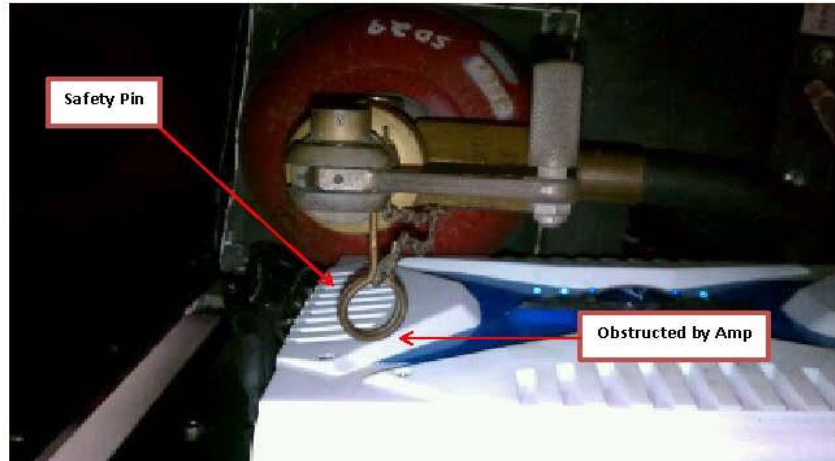
