Symptom 402000 Cooling System Concerns

Issue:

Loss of coolant, low level coolant warning displayed in the instrument cluster.

Cause:

Supplier quality issue - Radiator is found to be leaking from the inlet (top) tank left hand end clench (see attached picture for reference)

Action:

Replace radiator, part number LR034553.

Content From the production dates of parts sent to Service (Neovia) the only affected radiators in <u>service stock</u> will have a date code of **12th Jan 2013** on the label (see attached example).

If the radiator ordered from parts has a date code label other than 12th Jan 2013 it is ok to use.

This SSM will be replaced with a Technical Bulletin at a later date.

NOTE – Service stock was recalled and checked by the supplier, however if stock has been held at a Dealer it is recommended to check the date code prior to fitment.
