


DCC Fuse Installation During PDS

Installation Procedure

Remove the DCC fuse (20A) from the blank space of the Fuse Block in the engine compartment and install it in its original location as shown.

- · Removing the DCC fuse cuts off power sources relating to the DOME and MPX-B fuses.
- If the vehicle is stored at the dealership for a long period of time after PDS, disconnect
 the negative (–) battery terminal to prevent battery discharge. Refer to Service Bulletin
