Introduction

To minimize battery discharge during transportation and storage, the DCC fuse (30A) has been removed at the assembly plant and temporarily stored in the blank space of the fuse block in the engine compartment.

During Pre-Delivery Service (PDS), reinstall the DCC fuse into its original location.



Installation Procedure

Remove the DCC fuse (30A) from the blank space of the fuse block in the engine compartment and install it in the location shown in Figure 1 during Pre-Delivery Service (PDS).
