







Starting the week of June 30, 2014, Subaru retailers will receive the first wave of special service tools and equipment for the 2015 Legacy and Outback. This shipment will include:


<u>Illustration</u>	<u>Tool Number</u>	<u>Description</u>
	18360AA040	Engine Bracket This is the front attachment point for lifting the H4. It requires the previously shipped BRZ Engine Bracket Bolt (9011914120).
	18334AA040	Cam Pulley Wrench Adapter Used with the previously shipped Pulley Wrench (18355AA000) on the 2.5L H4 exhaust cam sprocket.
	18460AA050	Check Harness Used for back probing the waterproof ECM harness
	99099AL000	Rear Brake Caliper Dust Seal Installer

	<p>98299AL010</p>	<p>Airbag Test Harness Used with previously shipped test harness (98299AG070) to measure voltage and resistance of the airbag control module.</p>
	<p>98299AL000</p>	<p>Airbag Test Harness Used with previously shipped airbag deployment harness (98299PA030).</p>
	<p>98299AL030</p>	<p>ODS Test Harness Used to measure voltage and resistance of the seat belt tension sensor</p>
	<p>98299AL020</p>	<p>ODS Test Harness Used to measure voltage and resistance of the occupant detection system.</p>
	<p>87599VA000</p>	<p>EyeSight Chart, version 3 Used to calibrate the new version of EyeSight found in the 2015 Legacy and Outback. It is not compatible with systems that require the previously shipped EyeSight Chart version 2 (87599YC001).</p>
	<p>18767AA010 and 18767AA020</p>	<p>Bearing Puller Used during disassembly of the TR580 CVT transfer clutch assembly. This goes back to the 2012 Impreza.</p>

	<p>J-51443</p>	<p>TPMS Tester</p> <p>This replaces the previously shipped J-45295 Tire Monitor. It wakes up sensors, reads out their ID numbers, and also verifies operation of certain key fobs. Customized with Subaru software. Pairing sensors to the vehicle requires both this tool and the Select Monitor.</p>
	<p>18270AA040</p>	<p>Transfer Clutch Pressure Port Plug Socket</p> <p>Used together with the previously shipped wrench (73099SG000) to remove and properly torque the CVT pressure port plug on the 2015 Legacy and Outback.</p>

The cost of this first wave of tools and equipment for the 2015 Legacy and Outback is \$1953.86. They should arrive at all Subaru stores between 6/30/14 – 7/11/14.

The following tool will be shipped at the end of July at no additional cost:

	<p>J-51658</p>	<p>Engine Support Bridge Adapter</p> <p>Allows the front of the previously shipped Engine Support Bridge (J-50135) to slot into the mounting points on the 2015 Legacy and Outback.</p>
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The following tools and equipment will be shipped towards the end of the summer:

- Radar Reflector
- Radar Reflector Stand
- Subaru Leak Detection System
