TRANSMISSION OIL COOLER BOLTS Prevost vehicles

DESCRIPTION

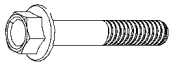
On the vehicles affected by this bulletin, inspect the transmission oil cooler to make sure it is properly secured. In certain material conditions, the bolts may extend beyond the threaded length of the mounting holes in the cooler creating a condition where the support is not tight on the cooler frame. Change the mounting bolts if required.

PROCEDURE



Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine. In the battery box, set the battery cut-off switch to the OFF position prior to working on the vehicle.

1. Lift vehicle
2. On the left side of transmission, check that the 4 mounting bolts on the oil cooler properly tighten the cooler on the support bracket.

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3. If play is present, change the four (4) mounting bolts for 5001307.
