The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this Pl.

Condition/Concern

Customers may comment on erratic idle, idle surge or sag, and other low engine speed drivability concerns especially in hot weather and after extended idle times.

This concern is on Tahoe Police Pursuit Vehicles (PPV) does not include Special Service Tahoes (5W4) or retail trucks. PPV only.

Recommendation/Instructions

To correct the above concern, update the ECM calibration (Engine Operation) with a calibration in TIS2Web titled "New calibration to address idle sag in high ambient temperatures."
