## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Bluetooth Connection Issues Between Samsung Galaxy S III And Vehicle Radio

Models: 2013 Buick LaCrosse, Regal

2013 -14 Buick Encore, Verano

2013 -14 Chevrolet Camaro, Cruze, Equinox, Malibu, Volt

2013 -14 GMC Terrain

Equipped with an IntelliLink/MyLink Radio (RPO UFU w/UP9 or UHQ)

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

## Condition/Concern

A customer may comment that his/her Samsung Galaxy S III exhibits the following condition(s):

- Does not connect to the vehicle
- · Loses Bluetooth connection to the vehicle

## Recommendation/Instructions

The issue can be resolved by updating the phone to the latest Android system software which begins with 4.4. Advise the customer to check that they have the latest software version available installed on their phone. Once the phone is updated, it is necessary to delete the phone from the Bluetooth Device List in the radio and delete the radio from the Bluetooth paired device from the phone. Once that is completed, the phone and radio can be paired once again.

Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
