# TECHNICAL

Subject: Shift Lever Contacts Ignition Key

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 2015 Chevrolet Silverado, Suburban, Tahoe 2014 GMC Sierra 1500 2015 GMC Sierra, Yukon, Yukon XL Without Keyless Engine Start Switch (Push Button) (RPO BTM)

#### Condition

Some customers may comment that if the tilt steering column is in the full-up position and the shift lever is moved between gears, the shift lever contacts the head of the ignition key. Some contact force may rotate the ignition key and shut the engine off. When this condition occurs, the brake pedal was applied.

The vehicle is equipped with a shift lock control system which prevents an inadvertent shift out of PARK when the engine is running. The driver must press the brake pedal before moving the shift lever out of the PARK position.

### Correction

A new design ignition key has been released. Technicians should replace the ignition key with the latest design. Refer to the pictures below for identification of the old key (1) versus new key (2).
