Condition/Concern

A customer may comment that OnStar WIFI is inoperative after a VCIM replacement or after a reprogramming event.

Recommendation/Instructions

"WIFI Activation" is now available in TIS2WEB.

Verify the vehicle has WIFI option by verifying the vehicle has RPO VV4.

Enter into TIS2WEB SPS programming and complete the VCIM Setup, Activation, and then WIFI Enable when performing a replacement or reprogramming event

Note: If the WIFI Enable is performed prior to the VCIM Setup and Activation, the WIFI Enable will turn back off.

If WIFI is still inoperative after the completion of the Setup, Activation, and WIFI Enable, please record the following information from GDS2/ Telematic Control Module/ Identification Information and call GM Technical Assistance for further direction.
