Title: ProStar Side Skirt Paint Mismatch

Applies To: ProStar

Paint mismatch is an optical illusion due to the sun reflecting off the part at different angles.

Metallic parts will show this “flop” more so than non-metallic, but it will be evident regardless.

The entire panel is molded and painted as one piece (the breakline is a molded breakline, not a joint between two parts).

This rear piece is sharply angled from the main piece in order to increase aerodynamic performance. Making a change to improve paint appearance would require a compromise on aerodynamic performance.

Below is an example of how rotating the same part 45° and then 90° will completely change the appearance of the part.
