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Title: Lonestar Filler Panels Interfere With Door Operation

Applies To: Lonestar

DESCRIPTION

Cab filler panels interfere with the doors

SYMPTOMS

- Paint damage and door operation

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Verify the complaint ([Figure 1](#))

RESOLUTION

1. Please remove the air filter cover by loosening the two thumb screws at the bottom of the assembly.
2. There is a black plastic strap at the bottom of the air cleaner. Please pull this outboard and this should release the cover and allow it to slide down. Be sure to disconnect the wiring harness if the air cleaner has lights.
3. Remove the air cleaner element.
4. Remove the six nuts located behind the air cleaner. ([Figure 2](#))
5. Loosen the air cleaner intake pipe and carefully remove the air filter housing. ([Figure 3](#))
6. Loosen the three adjusting bolts that where behind the filter housing, the bolt behind the marker light, and the bolt that is installed from the backside of the modesty panel. ([Figure 4](#))

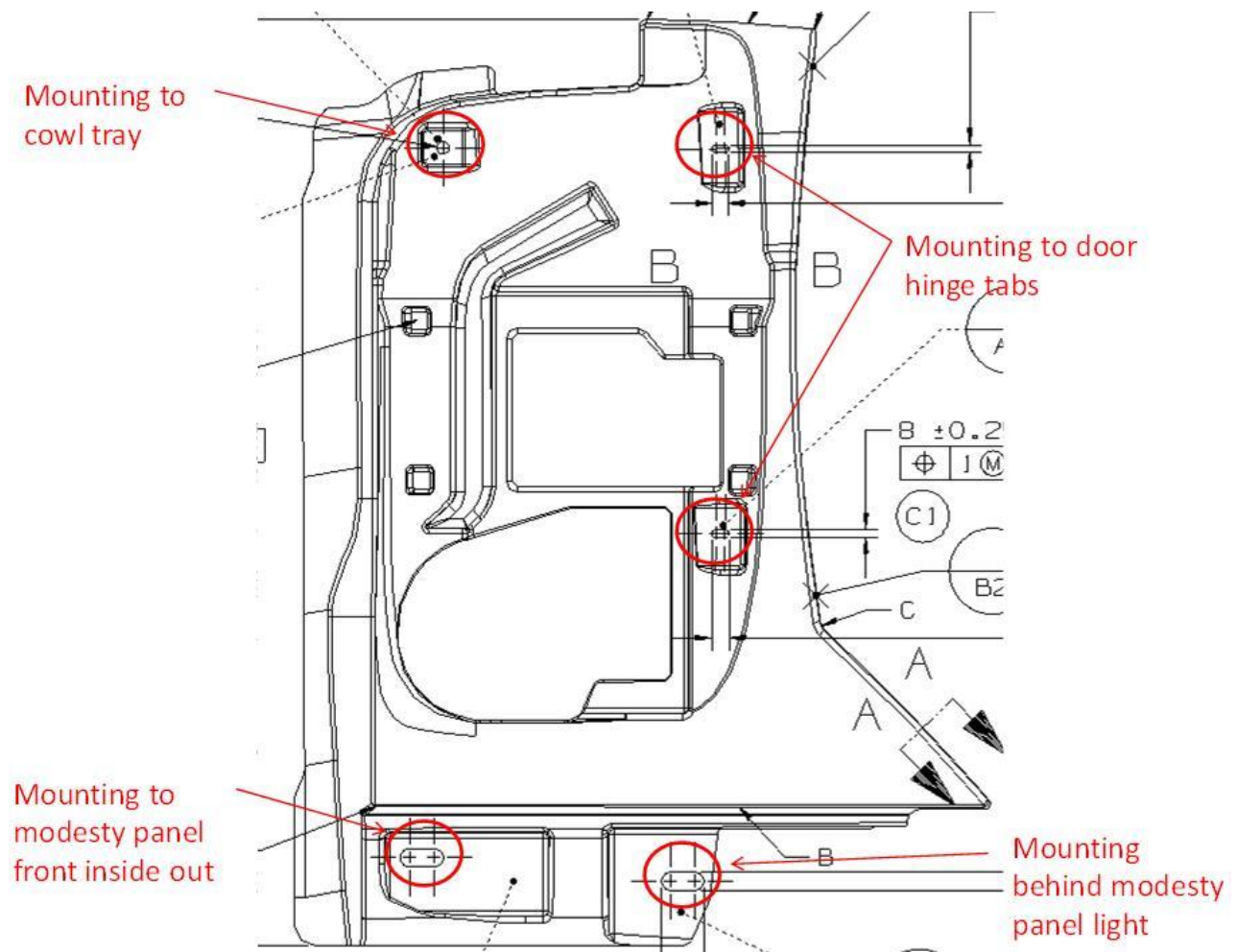
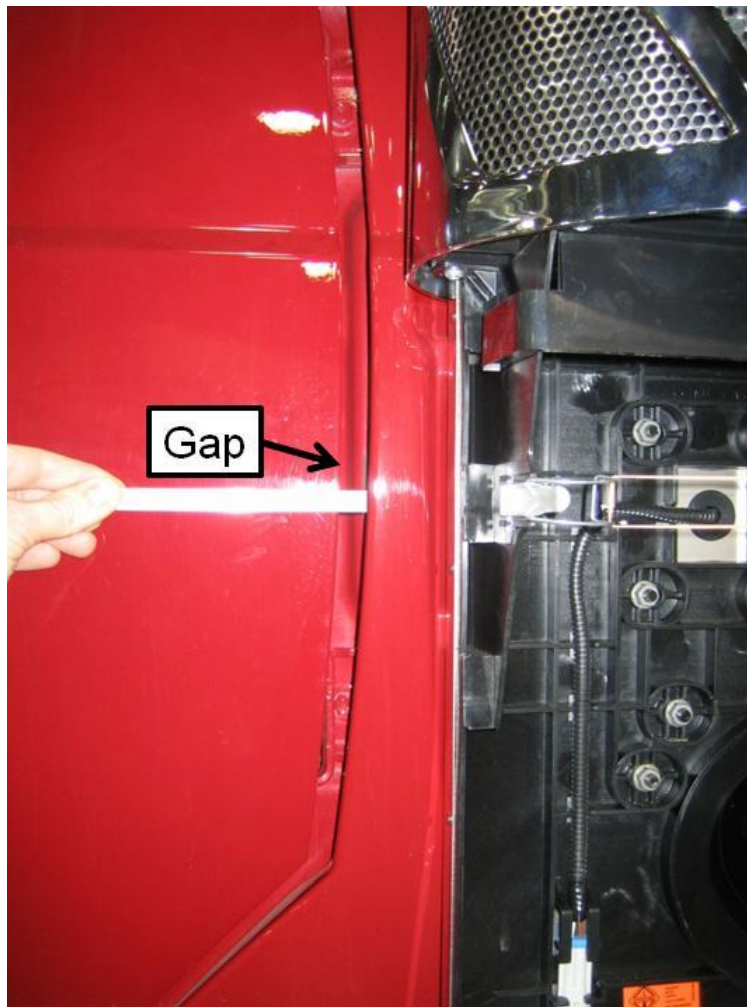


Figure 5

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

7. Close the hood and carefully shift the panel as required to get even spacing between the door and panel and maintain spacing between the hood and filler panel. **Specs 14mm +/- 2mm** ([Figure 5](#))
8. Tighten the five filler panel adjusting bolts. **11-13.6 N-M.**
9. Reinstall the air filter housing and adjust in the slotted holes as required. Be sure to tighten the intake pipe clamp.
10. Install the filter and cover as required. Reconnect light wiring harness if installed.

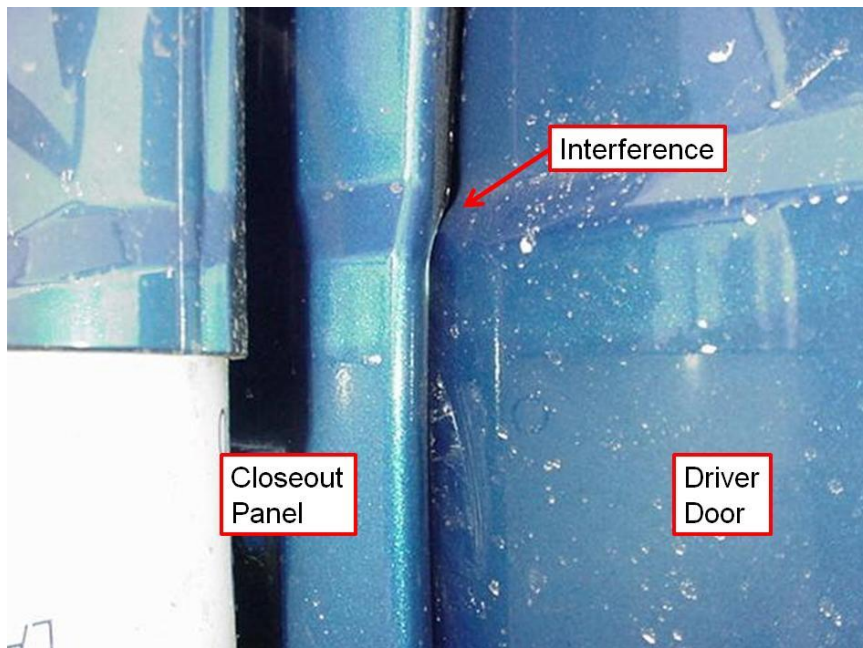
