

WE47 - Storing Collapsible Spare Wheel in Luggage Compartment Pan (Workshop Campaign)

Model Line: **Macan**

Model Year: **2015**

Equipment: 18-inch collapsible spare wheel (l-no. 1G1)

Concerns: **Collapsible spare wheel**

Information: This is to inform you of a voluntary Workshop Campaign on the above-mentioned vehicles. **The collapsible spare wheel could not be stored in the luggage compartment pan under the loadspace floor on the affected vehicles as planned during the production process due to a supply bottleneck.**

The vehicles were therefore supplied with a tyre sealing compound cartridge instead of the collapsible spare wheel. This cartridge is stored behind the left side trim panel in the luggage compartment.

Action Required: **Store collapsible spare wheel in the luggage compartment pan under the loadspace floor.**



Information

The tire sealing compound can remain in the vehicle. After the expiry date, the tire sealing compound must be disposed of in accordance with country-specific regulations and must no longer be replaced.

Affected Vehicles: The VIN(s) can be checked by using PIWIS Vehicle Information link to verify if the campaign affects the vehicle. This campaign is scope specific to the VIN! Failure to verify in PIWIS may result in an improper repair. This campaign affects 1,788 vehicles in North America.

Parts Info: **NOTE:** DO NOT ORDER PARTS. THEY WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ALLOCATED FOR UP TO 50% OF THE VEHICLES THAT ARE SERVICED AT YOUR DEALERSHIP. ONCE YOUR DEALERSHIP IS OUT OF STOCK AND REQUIRES ADDITIONAL PARTS, YOU SHOULD SUBMIT A PTEC/PAV.
