- 1. Perform a test drive to duplicate the rattling noises. When the rattling noises occur, apply slight brake pressure:
 - If the rattle noise stops, continue to step 2.
 - If the rattle noise does not change, this TSB does not apply.
- 2. Inspect the front brake retaining springs. If either of the springs does not have enough tension or appears to be broken or deformed (Figure 1), replace both springs.

Note: Always replace both springs, even if only one spring is affected.
