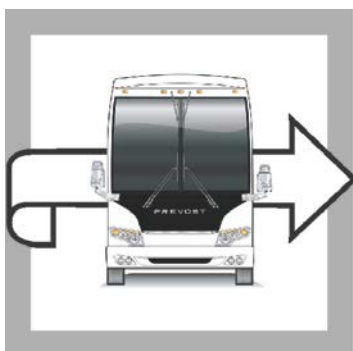

This bulletin does not necessarily apply to all the above-mentioned vehicles, some vehicles may have been modified before delivery. The owners of the vehicles affected by this bulletin will be advised by a letter indicating the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) of each vehicle concerned.	

DESCRIPTION

On the vehicles affected by this bulletin, a new center mount battery box cover offering better overall sealing and simplified installation is available and may be installed at next service occasion.

The procedure below lists the steps required to perform this modification.

MATERIAL

Kit #068875 includes the following parts:

NOTE

Material can be obtained through regular channels.

PROCEDURE



DANGER

Park vehicle safely, apply parking brake, stop engine and **set battery master switch(es) to the OFF position** prior to working on the vehicle.

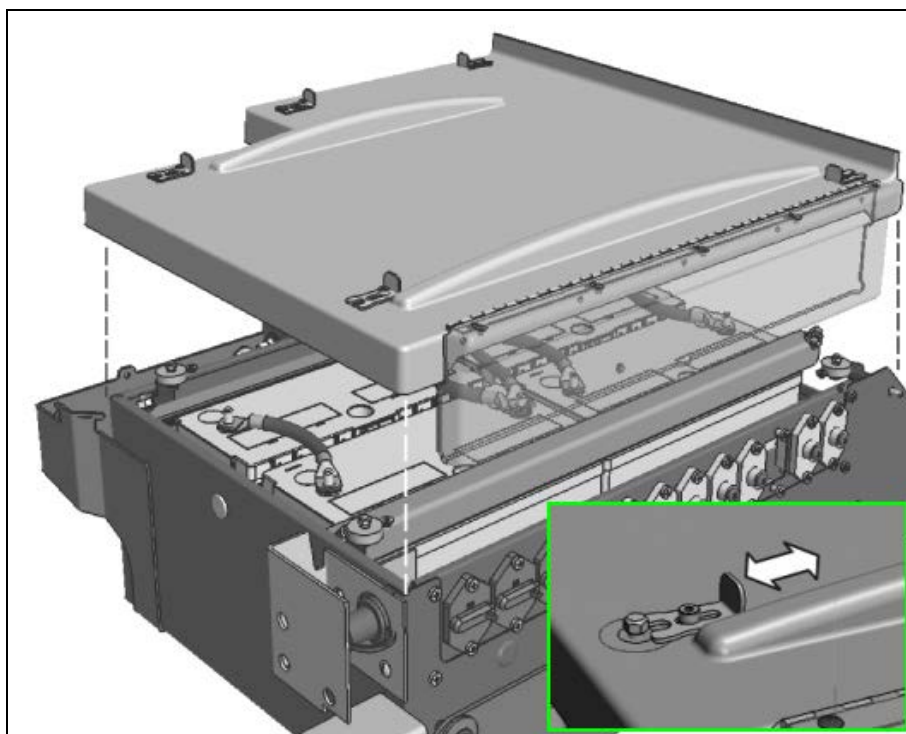


Fig.1 Removal of the five(5) latches cover.

1. In the vehicle right engine compartment, locate the battery box and remove the box cover (Fig.1).

2. Disconnect the four (4) vehicle batteries.



CAUTION

The negative (ground) cables must be disconnected first.

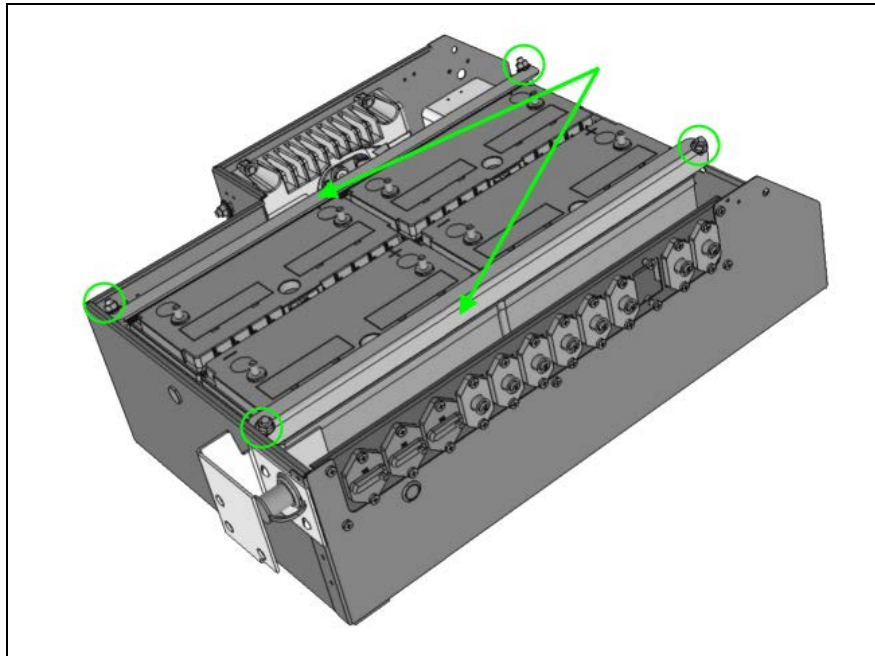


Fig.2 Retaining bars and hex nuts.

3. Remove the two (2) bars that maintain the batteries to the battery box (4 nuts Fig.2).

4. Remove the batteries from the vehicle.



CAUTION

To prevent electrolyte leakage, do not tip battery by more than 45° when carrying or installing the battery.

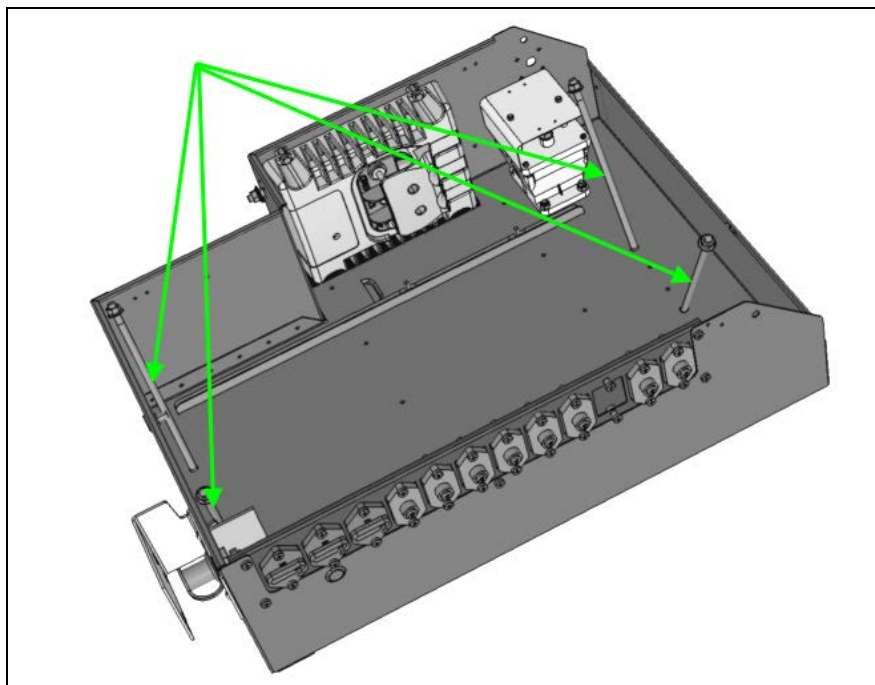


Fig.3 Retaining rods.

5. Remove the four (4) bars hold-down rods (Fig.3).

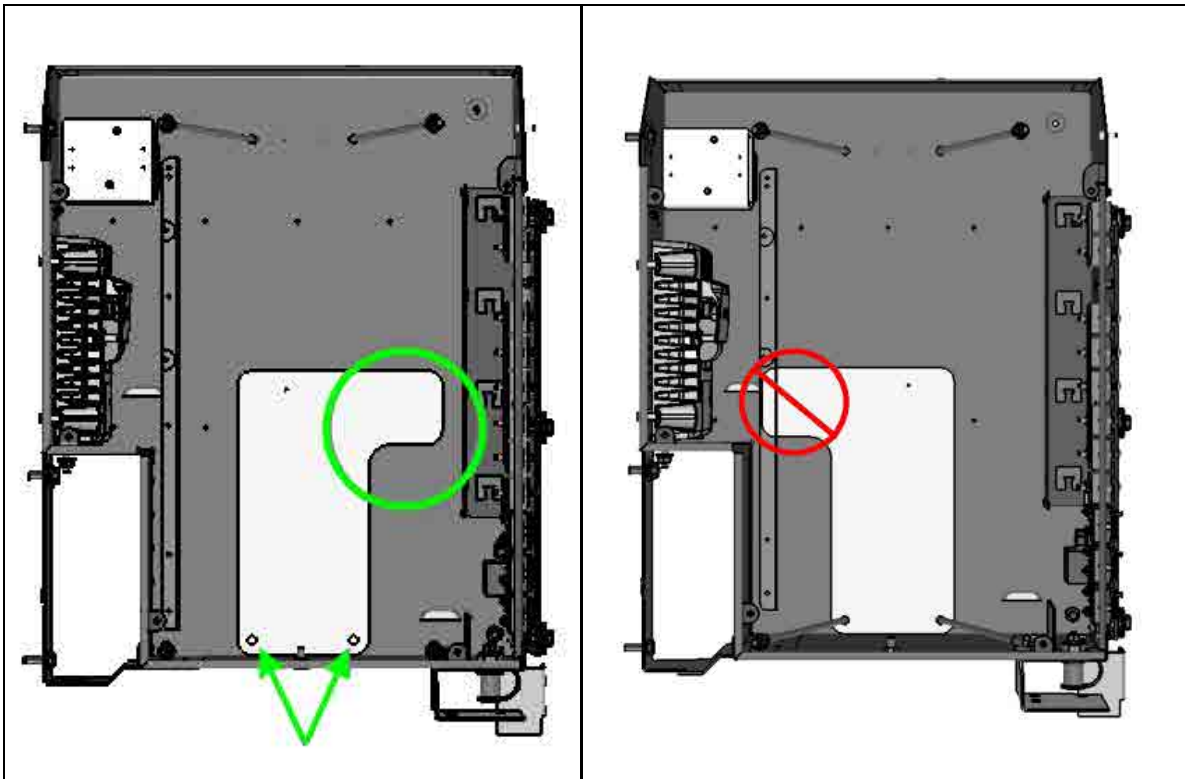


Fig.4 Correctly positionned drilling template shown on the left.

6. Position the drilling template at the bottom of the battery box using the hold-down rods holes (Fig.4).

NOTE: The drilling template is designed with a foolproof tab and can not be installed backward.

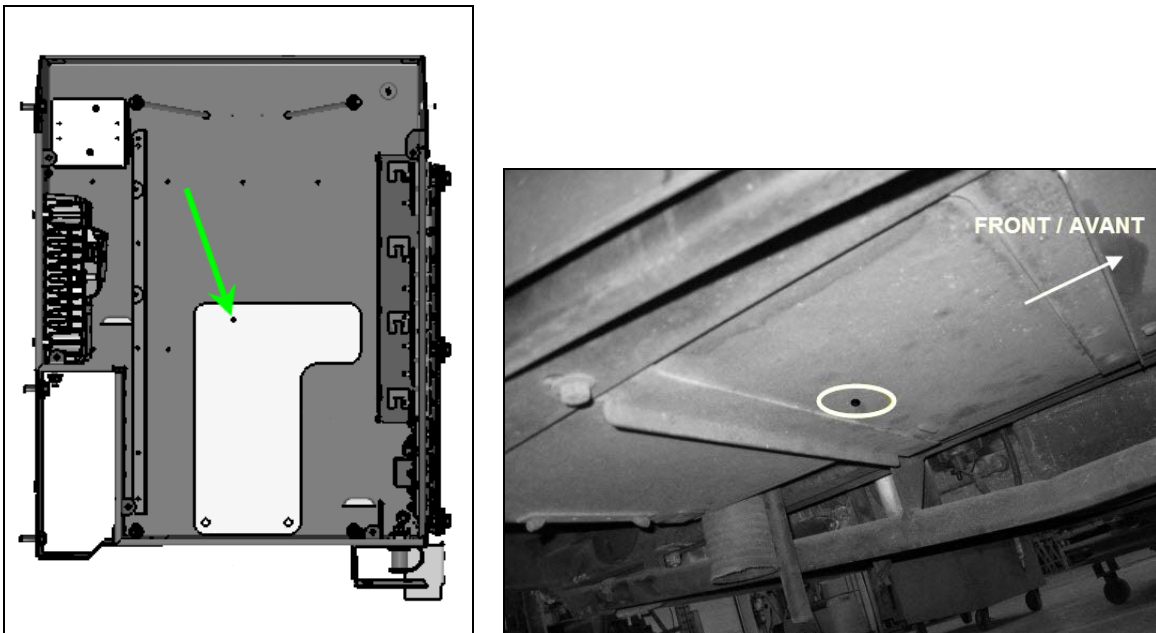


Fig.5 Drilling position viewed from top (Left) and bottom (Right) of the vehicle.

7. With the drilling template installed, drill through the box bottom using a 3/8po or 10mm drill bit (Fig.5).

8. Remove the drilling template.
9. Install the new battery box cover rod (068867) at the bottom of the box. From the vehicle underside, hand tight the rod using the supplied 3-8-16 hex nut (500702) and the flat washer (068704).

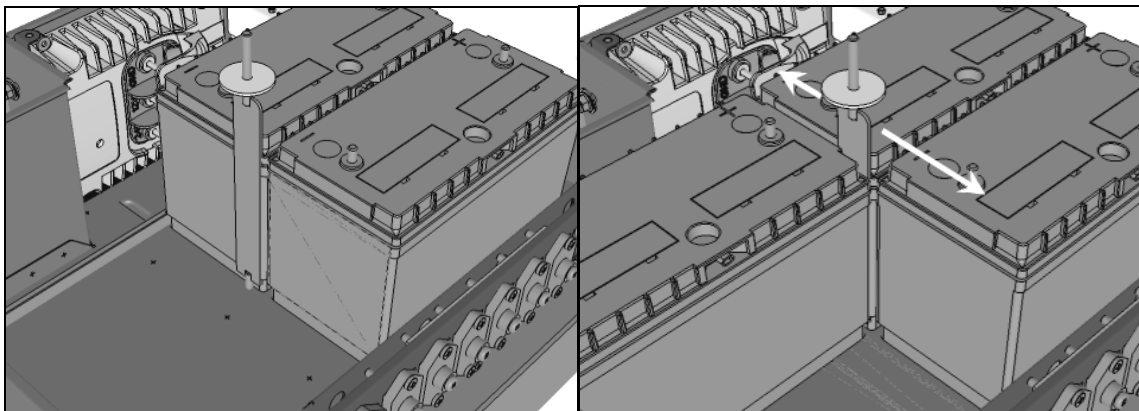


Fig.6 Battery box cover rod correct positioning.

NOTE: The rod flat section must be positioned along the width of the box (Fig.6)

10. With the rod correctly positioned, torque down the 3/8-16 hex nut to 30 ft-lb (40 Nm).
11. Reinstall the four (4) bars hold-down rods (Fig.3).

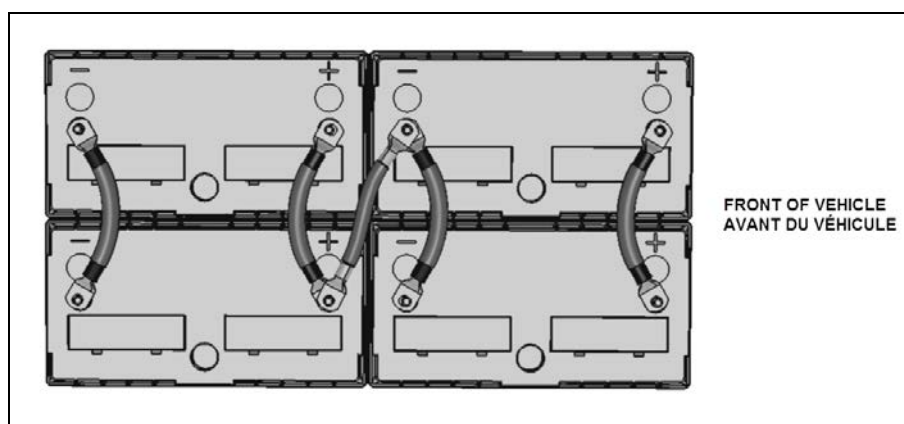


Fig.7 Positioning of the batteries in the battery box (positive and negative terminals)

12. Reinstall the batteries following Fig.7 bellow.

13. Secure the batteries in the box with the two (2) hold-down bars.

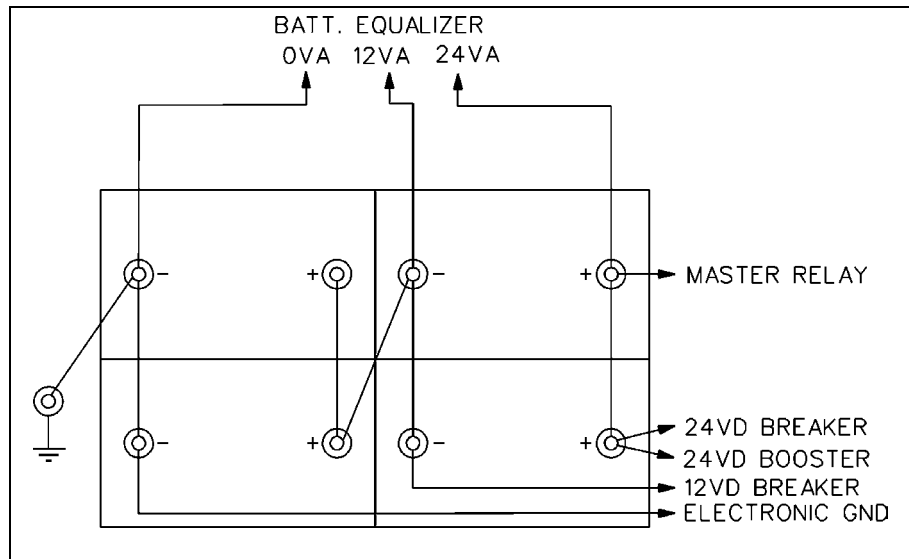


Fig.8 Batteries installation and connexion.

14. Reconnect the batteries following Fig.8 bellow.



CAUTION

The positive (power) cables must be connected first.

NOTE: When reinstalling batteries, battery connections must be tightened to 13-15 lb-ft (18-20 Nm).

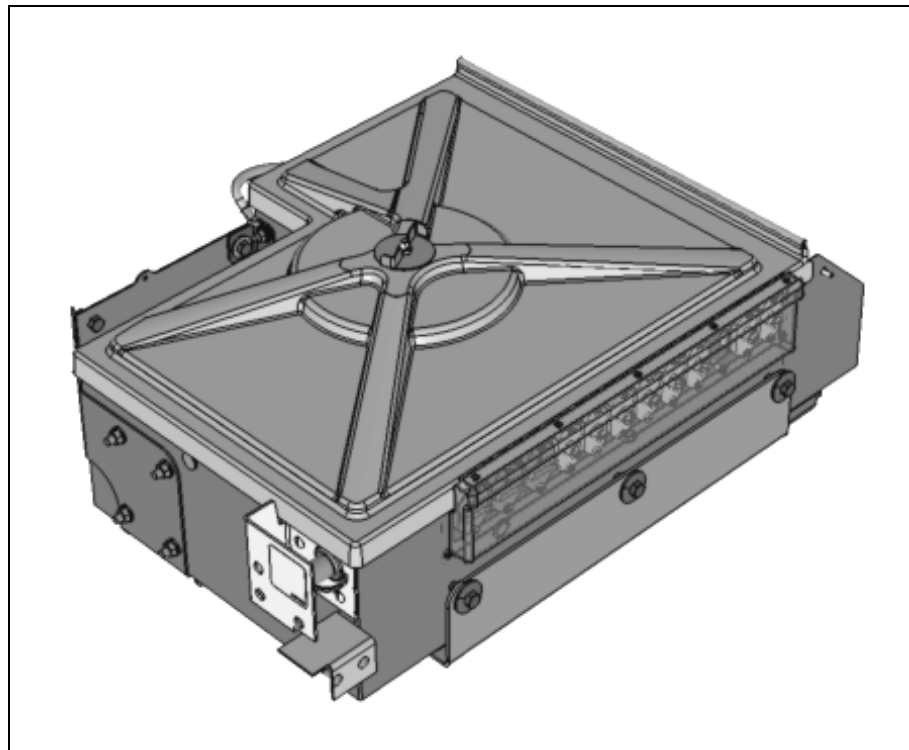


Fig.9 New cover installed

15. Install and tighten the new battery box cover (068858) using the provided wing nut (068765), check for proper fitting of the assembly (Fig.9).

16. Set the battery master switch to the RUN (ON) position and start the vehicle.
