Introduction

The DCC fuse (20A) has been removed at the assembly plant to reduce parasitic draw during transportation and storage. The DCC fuse is stored in the blank space of the Fuse Block in the engine compartment and must be installed in its original location during Pre-Delivery Service (PDS).



Installation Procedure

Remove the DCC fuse (20A) from the blank space of the Fuse Block in the engine compartment and install it in its original location as shown.

NOTE

- Removing the DCC fuse cuts off power sources relating to the DOME and MPX-B fuses.
- If the vehicle is stored at the dealership for a long period of time after PDS, disconnect the negative (-) battery terminal to prevent battery discharge. Refer to Service Bulletin No. [PG001-06](#), "Battery Maintenance for In-Stock Vehicles & Pre-Delivery," for battery maintenance information.
