## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Diagnostic Tip: Radio Source Changes After Ignition Cycle

Models: 2013-2015 Buick Enclave

2013-2015 Chevrolet Traverse 2014-15 Chevrolet Captiva 2013-2015 GMC Acadia

Equipped with Radio RPO UHU, UG4, UGU, UGY, UGX, UHW, UHV, UI2, UI4, UI6, UI7, OR UI8

## Condition/Concern

Customer may state that when first starting the vehicle that the radio will be on a different source from what it was left on.

## **Recommendation/Instructions**

Advise the customer that if a USB, DVD, or CD is inserted that it may take up to one minute (time will vary based upon device used) for the radio to load and index a CD, USB, or DVD.

During this loading period, the radio may play the last radio source such as AM, FM, etc.. while waiting for the loading to complete.

Once the loading is complete, the radio will resume playing the USB, DVD, or CD if it was the last source used.

If the radio software is not up-to-date (prior to software version 23441388) the radio may stay muted and display "CD/USB/DVD indexing or loading" until the CE is ready to play.

Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
