## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Radio Turns Off and On Unwanted

Models: 2011 - 2015 Chevrolet Cruze

## Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on any of the following conditions:

- ⇒ The Radio/HVAC Display turns off and on at times
- ⇒ The ABS, Service Traction System and Service StabiliTrak telltale lights come on
- ⇒ Service Steering Message displaying in the Driver Information Center (DIC) and may experience heavier steering feel at low speed or static steering maneuvers

Further, Technician may find the following DTC set in the EBCM, C0800 with symptom bytes 00, 03 or 07. Checking the radio and other modules may also find DTC's B1325 and or B1517 with symptom bytes 00, 03 or 07 set.

At engine idle and vehicle in Park, turning the HVAC blower to high speed, turning on the rear window defroster, activate heated seats and rolling windows up and down while turning the steering wheel may assist in duplicating the customers concern.

Please contact GM TAC for further information on repair direction if the vehicle exhibits any of these conditions.
