
### **Condition/Concern**

Customers may comment when pressing the steering wheel control "Push to Talk" switch the IPC displays a message "Unable to Start Speech Recognition" but the speech recognition still functions.

#### **Recommendation/Instructions**

Please reprogram the IPC selecting "Instrument Cluster USB File Transfer" using TIS2Web.

**Note:** Do not cycle the ignition until instructed to do so by the radio display. Please ignore the programming progress bar, the programming event is finished when you see the following screen on the radio display.



The system must be restarted in order to complete the update process. Please turn vehicle off, open and close driver door, and wait at least one minute before starting vehicle.
