Subject: Informational Front And Rear Fuse Block Terminated Leads

Models: 2011-2015 Chevrolet Volt

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

During normal diagnosis, a dealer technician may comment that they cannot locate the Terminals for the following fuse blocks to perform a service repair

1. X51L Left Instrument Fuse block
2. X51R Right Instrument Fuse block
3. X53 Rear Fuse block

Recommendation/Instructions

The Terminal is a rosebud terminated lead that is currently not available from SPO. At this time, the terminated leads can only be ordered through the Warranty Parts Center (WPC).
