PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Buzz/Rattle Noise from Rear Speaker Area

Models: 2011-2014 Chevrolet Camaro Convertible Equipped with Premium Audio System (RPO UQA) Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a buzz or rattle type noise coming from the rear speaker area. This may be caused by the sub woofer wiring coming in contact with the sub woofer cone.

Recommendation/Instructions

Technicians should inspect and adjust the sub woofer wiring. Make sure the blue wire is resting on the metal frame and not on the cone paper. Follow the procedure and refer to the pictures below.

1. Lower the convertible top.





2. Remove the left and right seat belt trim panels.



3. Remove the center trim panel.


- 4. Using a flat bladed tool, release the seat back retainers through the access holes located between the seat back cushion and the rear end trim finish upper panel.
- 5. Fold the seat back cushion down and line up the flats on the hinge pins with the slots on the hinges.
- 6. Pull the seat back cushion upward to remove it from the vehicle.




7. Remove the four nuts securing the sub woofer.



8. Remove the sub woofer from the opening.

- 9. Inspect the sub woofer wiring and verify the wiring is not in contact with the sub woofer cone paper (1). Adjust the blue wiring if needed and ensure the wire is resting outside the metal frame (2).
- 10. Install the sub woofer and nuts to the vehicle.
- 11. Install the seat back cushion.
- 12. Install the center trim panel.
- 13. Install the left and right seat belt trim panels.
- 14. Lower the convertible top.
