Some customers may comment that the 110 volt power inverter accessory power outlet (APO) shuts off during accessory plug in and will not reset until unplugged.

Many components such as laptop computers have a larger than posted rating in-rush surge that occurs when the capacitors are significantly discharged.

Recommendation/Instructions

The new Accessory AC and DC Power Control Module listed in Parts information has a "soft-start" function that will shut off momentarily during this condition but will continue to retry to power to a steady state as the accessory component capacitors load and the in-rush surge is overcome.

Technicians should replace the Accessory AC and DC Power Control Module. Refer to Accessory AC and DC Power Control Module Replacement in SI.
