2013–14 Odyssey: MIL Comes On With DTC P0404

(Supersedes 13-095, dated November 12, 2013, to revise the information marked by the black bars)

REVISION SUMMARY

- Under Applies To, 2013 Odyssey was added, and the 2014 Odyssey VIN range was changed.
- Under SOFTWARE INFORMATION, 2013 Odyssey was added.

SYMPTOM

The MIL comes on with DTC P0404 (EGR valve circuit range/performance problem).

POSSIBLE CAUSE

During extended driving, the PCM may command excessively high lift EGR values that may damage an internal EGR component.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Replace the EGR valve and update the PGM-FI software.





1. Remove the engine cover.



2. Disconnect the EGR valve 5-pin connector.



- 3. Remove the EGR valve.
- 4. Install the new EGR valve in the reverse order of removal.
- 5. Update the PGM-FI software. Refer to Service Bulletin 01-023, *Updating Control Units/Modules*.
