SUBJECT

My BMW Remote iPhone App No Longer Controls Headlight or Horn

MODEL

F01, F02 (7 Series Sedan)

F04 (ActiveHybrid 7)

F06 (6 Series Gran Coupe)

F10 (5 Series Sedan)

F12 (6 Series Convertible)

F13 (6 Series Coupe)

Produced from August 01, 2009 to June 30, 2012

SITUATION

After programming the vehicle with ISTA/P 2.49.x or higher, the headlight and the horn can no longer be controlled using the My BMW Remote App from an iPhone.

I-Level F001-13-03-501 or F010-13-03-501 and higher

Note: The lock and unlock function via the App works as designed.

CAUSE

A software error in the central gateway (ZGW) control unit

PROCEDURE

Do not replace parts or program the vehicle!

The following procedure should be performed:

1. Duplicate the issue with the customer.

Note: The customer's iPhone and account information will be needed to test functionality.

2. Verify the customer has a valid BMW Assist contract.

Contact BMW Assist at 1-888-333-6118.

- 3. Check that the iPhone is running IOS 6.0 or higher.
- 4. Check that the "My BMW Remote App" version is 2.8_r13160/13006 / 2.4.10 or higher.
