#### **SUBJECT**

**Service Action: Remove Front Bumper Air Inlet Panel** 

#### **MODEL**

F30 (3 Series Sedan)

Produced from June 26, 2014 to July 4, 2014

#### **SITUATION**

The front air cooling duct does not cool sufficiently. It may cause the engine to overheat, resulting in a Check Control message.

#### **CAUSE**

Certain vehicles were manufactured with a "sealed-off" front air cooling duct.

### **AFFECTED VEHICLES**

This Service Action involves F30 vehicles produced from June 26, 2014 to July 4, 2014.

First check if a Service Action label with a code number **705** is already attached to the B-pillar.

If a code number **705** has been punched out, the Service Action has already been performed and no further action is necessary.

Vehicles which require this Service Action to be completed will show it as "Open" when checked either in the "Service Menu" of DCSnet (Dealer Communication System) or with the Key Reader.

### **CORRECTION**


Remove the sealing panel from the front air cooling duct.

# **PROCEDURE**

Remove the sealing panel in the air cooling intake duct and discard.



1. The sealing panel is located on the right side of the front bumper, behind the air cooling intake grill.




2. Remove the fasteners from the front section of the right front wheel arch liner (1) and remove the wheel arch liner (2).



3. Unclip the sealing panel from the air duct by using a suitable pry tool. Discard.

Reinstall the wheel arch.

### LABEL INSTRUCTIONS



This Service Action has been assigned code number **705**. After the vehicle has been checked and/or corrected, obtain a label (SD 92-453) and:

- A. Emboss your BMW center warranty number in the middle of the label (1);
- B. Punch out code number **705** (2), printed on the label; and
- C. Affix the label to the B-pillar as shown.

If the vehicle already has a label from a previous Service Action/Recall Campaign, affix the new label next to the old one. Do not affix one label on top of another one because a number from an underlying label could appear in the punched-out hole of the new label.
