SUBJECT

Rear View Camera Does Not Display Image on CID

MODEL F12 (6 Series Coupe)

F13 (6 Series Convertible)

F06 (6 Series Gran Coupe)

Produced to July 8, 2014

With option 3AG (reversing camera)

Or

3AH (reversing camera and top view)

SITUATION

After engaging the reverse gear, the reversing camera does not display a picture in the CID (Central Information Display).

CAUSE

The drive mechanism for the roundel actuation in the boot lid is faulty.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Duplicate the issue.
- 2. All camera faults must be diagnosed using the latest ISTA version (3.44 or higher) and resolved prior to proceeding to the next step.

Always connect a BMW approved battery charger/power supply (SI B04 23 10).

3. Follow the test plan recommendations.

Note: Only replace the part which is recommended by the test plan. Do not replace both the reversing camera and the drive mechanism unless recommended by the test plan.

4. When reinstalling the reversing camera and the drive mechanism, the seal (rubber gasket) must be replaced.

Note: Reusing the original seal may allow water to leak into the luggage compartment.
