### **SUBJECT**

Delivery Stop/Service Action: Shock Absorber Rear Axle

#### **MODEL**

F56 (MINI Hardtop)


# NEW SITUATION

A rear shock absorber with a malfunctioning damper valve may have been fitted into some vehicles.

Important note: In the group of identified vehicles, only four shock absorbers in total are affected. The damper function of these four units is only partially effective.

These four shock absorbers can be identified, based on a particular date and serial number, as seen in the attachment M330114Labels.





### **AFFECTED VEHICLES**

This Service Action involves F56 MINI Hardtop vehicles produced from April 7, 2014 through May 14, 2014.

First check if a Service Action label with a code number 67 is already attached to the B-pillar.

If a code number 67 has been punched out, the Campaign has already been performed and no further action is necessary.


Vehicles which require this Service Action to be completed will show it as "Open" when checked either in the "Service Menu" of DCSnet (Dealer Communication System) or with the Key Reader.

# **NEW MEASURE**

Raise the vehicle on a lift and remove both rear wheels. Check the date and serial number on the rear shock absorber labels. If **BOTH** numbers, date and serial number, on the label are identical to one of the labels in the attachment M330114Labels, please note the VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) on the attachment page for the corresponding label and send it back to me via email at <a href="mailto:tom.digregorio@bmwna.com">tom.digregorio@bmwna.com</a>

Replace both shock absorbers (as a set) on the rear axle per Repair Instruction 37 12 130. See the attachment REP3712130.

Correctly position the VDCO cable as shown.




When positioning the connecting cable on the new shock absorber, both cables must be in one line.



Turn both plugs in the installed position. Push them down until they snap into place.

Fit the adapter plate




Do not dispose of the shock absorber. Return instructions will be supplied to you when an incorrect part has been identified.

#### LABEL INSTRUCTIONS



This Service Action has been assigned code number **67**. After the vehicle has been checked and/or corrected, obtain a label (MD20–064) and:

- A. Emboss your MINI dealer warranty number in the middle of the label (1);
- B. Punch out code number **67** (2), printed on the label; and
- C. Affix the label to the B-pillar as shown.

If the vehicle already has a label from a previous Service Action/Recall Campaign, affix the new label next to the old one. Do not affix one label on top of another one because a number from an underlying label could appear in the punched-out hole of the new label.
