SITUATION

Groaning noises are heard from the front axle area while maneuvering at low speeds (e.g., parking lot maneuvers) or over uneven road surfaces.

CAUSE

Hydraulic mount in tension strut

NEW PROCEDURE

Confirm the groaning noise is coming from the front axle area. Locate it on either the driver's or passenger's side. Replace the hydraulic mount for the affected side, following Repair Instruction 31 12 134.

NEW If the tension struts are already removed to perform another repair, use labor operation 31 12 646.

NEW Wheel alignment is not required for these repairs.
