SUBJECT

Panoramic Sunroof Does Not Open or Close

MODEL

F15 (X5)

SITUATION

One or both of the following may occur:

- 1. The sunroof becomes stuck during operation.
- 2. The sunroof cannot be opened or closed.

CAUSE

The panoramic sunroof rear glass mechanism fails.

• The drive cable plate is either broken or bent.


CORRECTION

The complete sunroof cassette must be replaced.

PROCEDURE

Perform the following steps:

- 1. Duplicate the issue.
- 2. Check the TLL number of the sunroof as follows:




- 3. Remove the FZD (front roof switch cluster).
- 4. Using special tool 00 9 325, carefully unclip the switch cover (1).

Installation Note:

Ensure the cover (1) is correctly aligned (seated).

- 5. Unlock the left and right retaining clips (1) with a screw driver (2), in the direction of the arrow.
- 6. Remove the switch cluster (3).



7. Unlock the plug connections and disconnect.

Installation Note:

Retaining clips (1) must not be damaged.

Ensure the roof switch cluster (3) is correctly fitted.



- 8. This picture shows the TLL number circled in green.
- 9. If the TLL number ranges from 30 to 38, the complete sunroof cassette must be replaced.
- 10. Refer to Repair Instruction 54 13 080, "Removing and installing complete glass slide/tilt sunroof."
- 11. If the TLL number falls outside the range of 30 to 38, this SI no longer applies. The technician must continue with his or her diagnosis using ISTA.
- 12. Retest the sunroof functionality.
