# 2013 ALTIMA SEDAN WITH STEEL WHEELS; REAR BRAKE NOISE

## IF YOU CONFIRM

A squeal/squeak noise is coming from the rear brakes:

- when the brakes are either hot (after 10-15 minutes of driving) or cold (after vehicle has not been driven for 2-3 hours),
- while moving forward or in reverse,
- at speeds less than 10 MPH,
- while traveling straight, AND
- with light to moderate brake application (pedal pressure).

**NOTE:** These are the typical conditions in which to duplicate the rear brake squeal/squeak; however, these conditions are not intended to detail all of the possible conditions in which the noise may occur. When attempting to duplicate this noise it is important to have a second person safely standing outside of the vehicle to determine if the noise is coming from the front or rear brakes.

#### ACTION

Replace the rear brake pads and the rear brake hardware kit with the parts listed in the Parts Information section of this bulletin.

• Refer to the Electronic Service Manual (ESM), section **BR–Brake System**, for removal and installation information.
