JX35 AND QX60; AUTOMATIC DRIVE POSITIONER LOSES MEMORY

APPLIED VEHICLES: 2013 JX35 (L50)

2014 QX60 (L50)

DATES: Vehicles built before 5N1ALOM(* *)EC 529260 and March 13, 2014

NOTE: This bulletin does not apply to QX60 Hybrid.

IF YOU CONFIRM:

With the ignition turned ON, the following Automatic Drive Positioner (ADP) related items operate as stated below:

- The driver's seat, outside mirrors, and steering wheel will not adjust to preset positions.
- Memory positions 1 and 2 do not work when their buttons are pressed.
- The LED memory position and set indicator light does not come on.
- The outside mirrors can NOT be adjusted with the power mirror switch.
- The driver's seat and steering wheel can be adjusted with the steering wheel switch.

ACTION:

Replace the BCM.

• For BCM replacement procedure, refer to the M ELECTRICAL & POWER CONTROL > BCS Body Control System section of the appropriate Electronic Service Manual (ESM).
