Climate Seats Inoperative

CONDITION SUMMARY:

Situation: The climate seats (front and/or rear) may be inoperative.

Cause: This may be caused by the ducting in the seat cushion(s) being blocked by excess foam. **Action:** Should a customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction outlined below.

SERVICE INSTRUCTION:

NOTE: Do not remove the cover from the seat cushion.

Remove the affected seat cushion (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-10).

2. NOTE: Front seat cushion shown; rear seat similar.

NOTE: Rear seat cushion has two holes for ducting; make sure both are clear.

Inspect all the ducting in the seat base cushion. If the ducting is blocked by excess foam, clear the excess by hand.



- 3. Install the seat cushion (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-10).
- **4.** Repeat steps 1-3 as necessary to other affected climate seat(s).
