This Update has been proactively released to prevent the following condition from occurring in the vehicle:

On Audi vehicles manufactured within a specific period, the refrigerant pressure sensor for the air conditioner may fail after a period of time. As a result, the air conditioner compressor is switched off.

This Update is in effect until removed.

Vehicle must meet all of the following criteria:

- Procedure is valid only for vehicles that show the 87D9 code in the Elsa Campaign/Action Information screen on the day of repair.
- Vehicle must be within the New Vehicle Limited Warranty.
- Procedure must be performed within the allotted time frame stated in this Technical Service Bulletin.
- Procedure must be performed on applicable vehicles in dealer inventory prior to sale.


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### **Service**

Remove the refrigerant pressure sensor
-G395- <A> by following the instruction in
ElsaPro >> Repair Manual >> Heating,
Ventilation and Air Conditioning >> 87 Air
Conditioning >> Removal and Installation >>
A/C Pressure/Temperature Sensor G395.



2. Check production date of sensor.

Example: 3 13612

3: Shift 1: Day 36: Week

12: Year (2012)

Replace sensor **ONLY** if the last 4 or 5 numbers are:

- 3212 - 3312 - 3412 - 3512 - 3612 - 3712 - 3812 - 3912

54612

- Record production date on repair order to be included on claim entry.
- If the sensor date is not within these ranges reinstall sensor with new o-ring, PN 7H0820896.
