46 Brake pad wear warning - pads not at minimum

Condition

The brake pad wear indicator comes on, but brake pad thickness is above the wear limit.

Technical Background

Water ingress into the connector housing of the brake pad wear indicator can lead to the oxidation of the pins. This oxidation can increase contact resistance in the connector, which can generate the warning.

Production Solution

Service

- 1. Disconnect the brake pad wear indicator electrical connector (at the harness). Use VAS 1978 B to remove both pins from the harness side connector.




Figure 1. Corrosion (black deposits) on connector pins.

- If corrosion is present on the pins (Figure 1), replace both the affected brake pad wear indicator and the ABS wheel speed sensor wiring harness to which the indicator connects.
