## Condition

#### Cause

GM Engineering is attempting to determine the root cause of the above condition. Engineering has a need to gather information on vehicles PRIOR to repair that may exhibit this condition. As a result, this information will be used to "root cause" the customer's concern and develop/validate a field fix.

# Instructions

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, perform the following steps.

- 1. Confirm that the noise is present.
- 2. Inspect the pad and rotor condition. Confirm that there is no physical damage such as deep rotor grooves or pad damage.
- 3. If the noise is present and there is no physical damage to the pads or rotor, please contact one of the engineers listed below for further instructions. The engineer may request parts back.
