The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

### Condition/Concern:

Some owners may comment on unwanted stability activation and/or a service stability message. The EBCM may have set DTC C0710. This concern may occur if the vehicle's suspension system has been modified (Lift or Lowering Kits), wheelbase length modified (limo, etc...), wrong steering gear installed, and/or other than stock size wheels and tires installed.

### Recommendation/Instructions:

Before any in-depth diagnostics are performed, be aware that this concern could occur if the vehicle has been modified.

ABS message tire wheel
