Some 2009-2011 E-Series vehicles equipped with a 4.6L or 5.4L engine may exhibit an illuminated MIL with DTC P0130 (Oxygen Sensor Circuit Bank 1, Sensor 1) or P0150 (Oxygen Sensor Circuit Bank 2, Sensor 1).

ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Retrieve all DTCs from the Powertrain Control Module (PCM). Are DTCs P0130 or P0150 present?
 - a. Yes proceed to Step 2.
 - b. No this article does not apply. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM) and Powertrain Control/Emissions Diagnosis (PC/ED) manual for normal diagnostics.

2. NOTE:

PLEASE ADVISE THE CUSTOMER THAT THIS VEHICLE IS EQUIPPED WITH AN ADAPTIVE TRANSMISSION SHIFT STRATEGY WHICH ALLOWS THE VEHICLE'S COMPUTER TO LEARN THE TRANSMISSION'S UNIQUE PARAMETERS AND IMPROVE SHIFT QUALITY. WHEN THE ADAPTIVE STRATEGY IS RESET, THE COMPUTER WILL BEGIN A RE-LEARNING PROCESS. THIS RE-LEARNING PROCESS MAY RESULT IN FIRMER THAN NORMAL UPSHIFTS AND DOWNSHIFTS FOR SEVERAL DAYS.
