SENTRA; NO CRANK NO START AND DTCs STORED

APPLIED VEHICLE: 2013 - 2014 Sentra (B17)

IF YOU CONFIRM:

The engine will not start (the starter does not operate)

AND

Any of the following DTCs are found stored:

- > P1650 (Starter Motor Relay 2)
- > P1651 (Starter Motor Relay)
- ▶ B210C (Starter Control Relay Off)

Combined with

One or more of the following DTCs:

B2562, B00A0, B142A, C1601

ACTION:

- 1) Test the battery with the GR8 Multitasking Battery Diagnostic Station (battery tester/charger).
 - a. If the battery passes testing, skip to step 2.
 - Charge the battery if required by the battery tester/charger.
 - b. If the battery does not pass testing, replace it.
 - Refer to WIN FAST or your Electronic Parts Catalog for the battery part number.
 - ➤ Make sure the replacement battery is fully charged and ready for service before releasing the vehicle to the customer.
 - Reset / Re-initialize Clock, Radio Presets, Power Windows, etc.
- 2) Erase all DTCs with CONSULT-III plus, and then confirm: The starter operates, the engine starts, and no DTCs stated above are stored after starting the engine.

CLAIMS INFORMATION

Submit a Primary Part (PP) type line claim using the following claims coding:

(1) Refer to the electronic parts catalog (FAST) and use the IPDM assembly part number (284B7-XXXXX) as the Primary Failed Part (PFP).

For battery testing, charging, and/or replacement: Use applicable claims coding in the Nissan Warranty Flat Rate Manual.
