Some 2011-2014 AWD Explorer vehicles built on or before 5/16/2014 may exhibit a Terrain Management pop-up warning in the instrument cluster without an accompanying diagnostic trouble code (DTC) in the all terrain control module or anti-lock brake system (ABS) module.

#### ACTION

Follow the Service Procedure steps to correct the condition.

## SERVICE PROCEDURE

- Reprogram the ABS module to the latest calibration using IDS release 90.02 and higher. Calibration files may also be obtained at www.motorcraft.com.
- 2. Perform interactive vehicle dynamics (IVD) initialization using IDS.
