

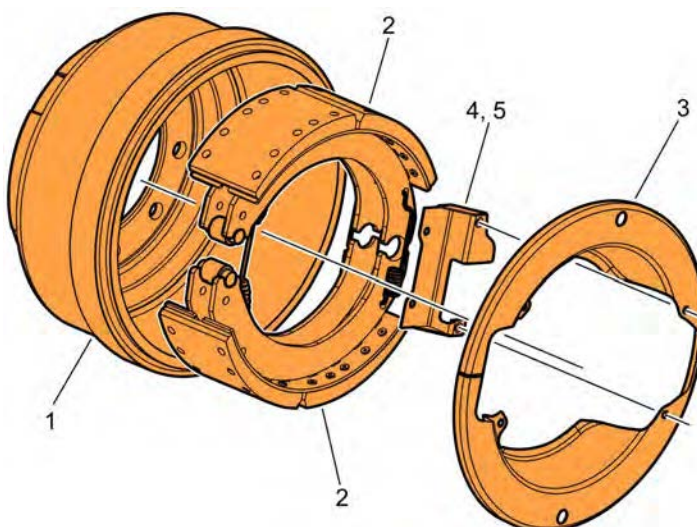

FSB 511-005, Brake Drum, Replacement (Steer Axle)

(August 2014)

Some VOLVO VN, VHD, VAH trucks built between 08/29/2011 and 06/30/2014, equipped with a Hendrickson or VOLVO 14.6k steer axle, and 152 mm (6.0 in) wide Bendix brake shoes can show signs of brake shoe protrusion beyond the brake drum. This condition is resolved by installing new 152 mm (6.0 in) brake shoes, new dust shields, new 178 mm (7.0 in) wide brake drums (20536276), and replacing the existing z-brackets.

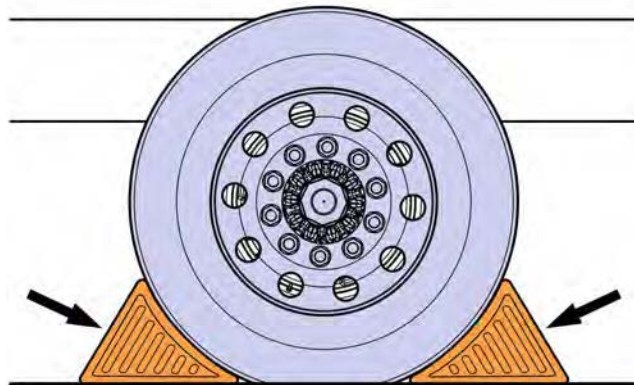

Decommissioning the Truck for Repair

You must read and understand the precautions and guidelines in Service Information, group 50, "General Safety Practices, Brakes" before performing this procedure. If you are not properly trained and certified in this procedure, ask your supervisor for training before you perform it.

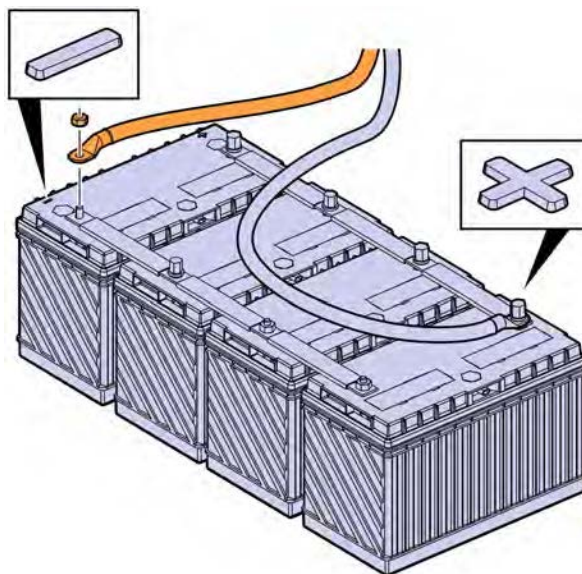

- 1 Park the vehicle on a flat and level surface.
- 2 Apply the parking brake.
- 3 Place the transmission in neutral or park.
- 4 Install the wheel chocks.



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- 5 Disconnect the cable from the battery's negative terminal.

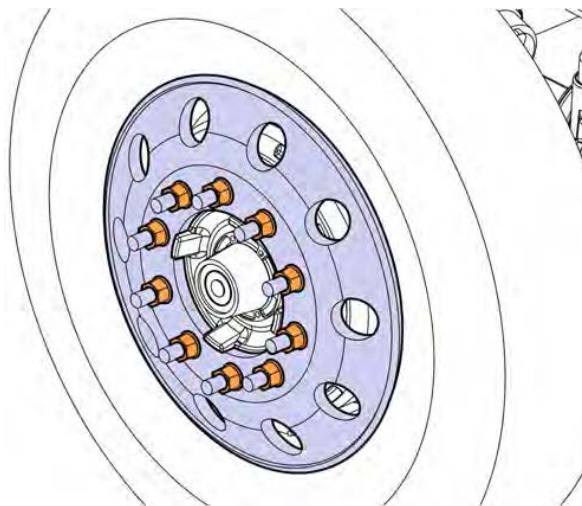

Brake Drum, Replacement, Bendix (1.0 hrs)

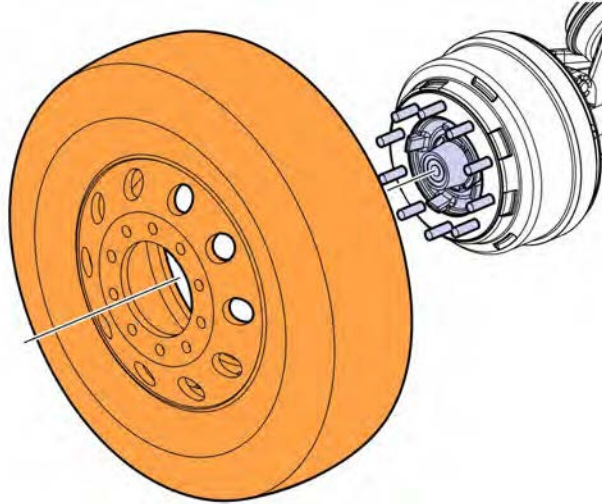
Note: The right side is shown for instructional purposes.

- 1 Lift the steer axle with a jack, place the truck on jack stands, and remove the jack.
- 2 Remove the wheel nuts.



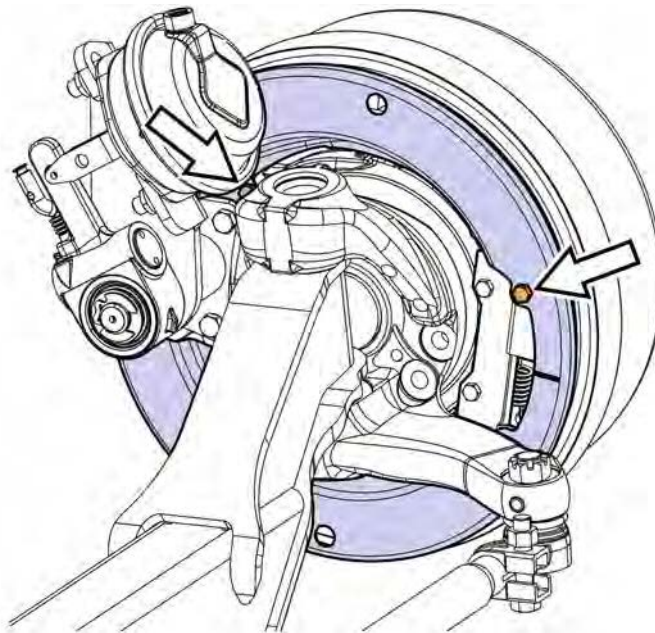

- 3 Remove the wheel.



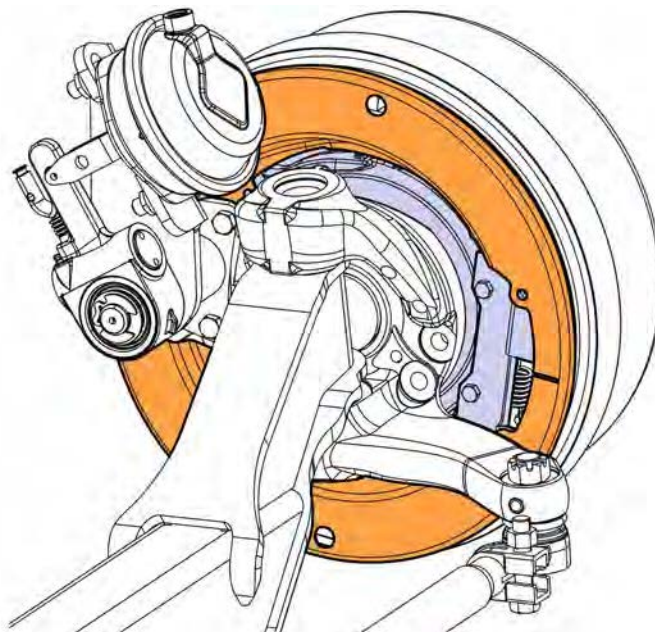
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- 4 Remove the four fasteners securing the existing dust Shield.



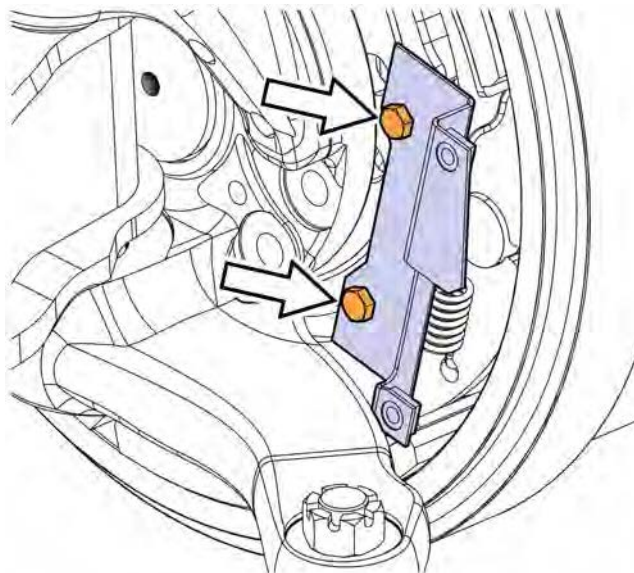
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- 5 Remove the dust shield.



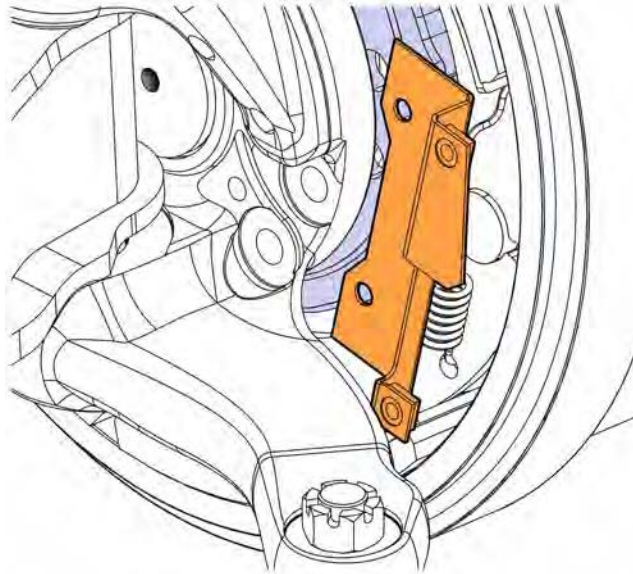
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- 6 Remove the fasteners securing the existing z-bracket.

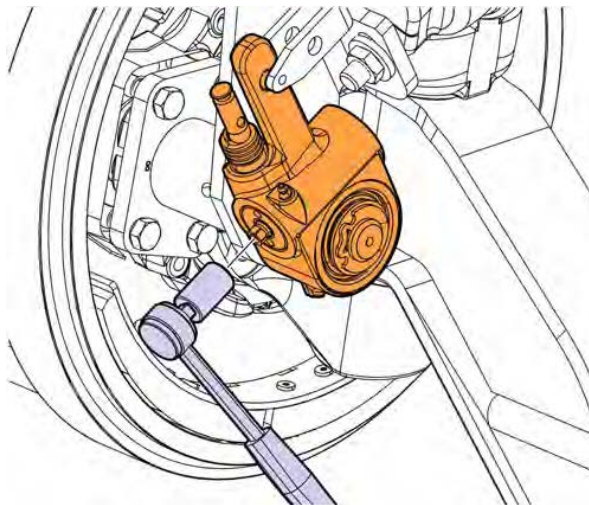
- 7 Remove the existing z-bracket.



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- 8 Back off of the brake (slack adjuster).

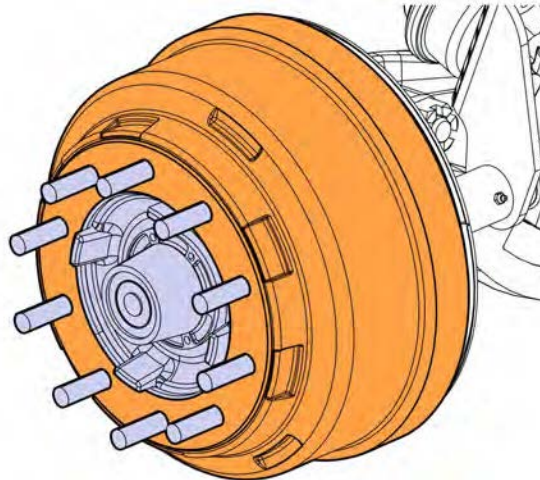
Note: The Gunitite slack adjuster is shown in this procedure for backing off the brakes. However, this procedure is similar for other brands.

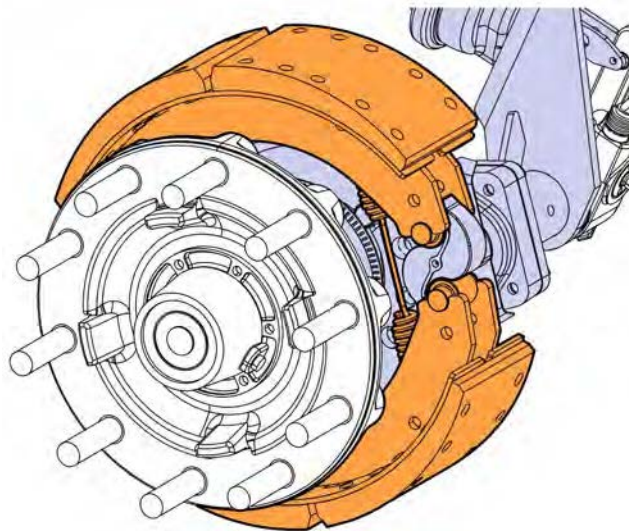
9 Remove the brake drum.

Note: Discard the brake drum.



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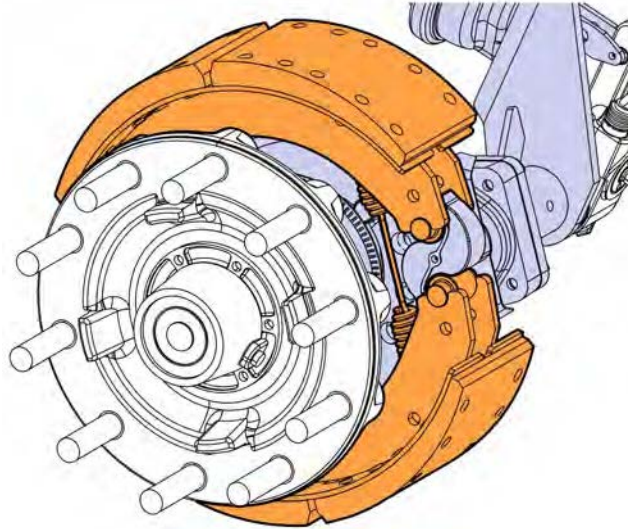
10 Remove the brake shoes, brake springs, and rollers.

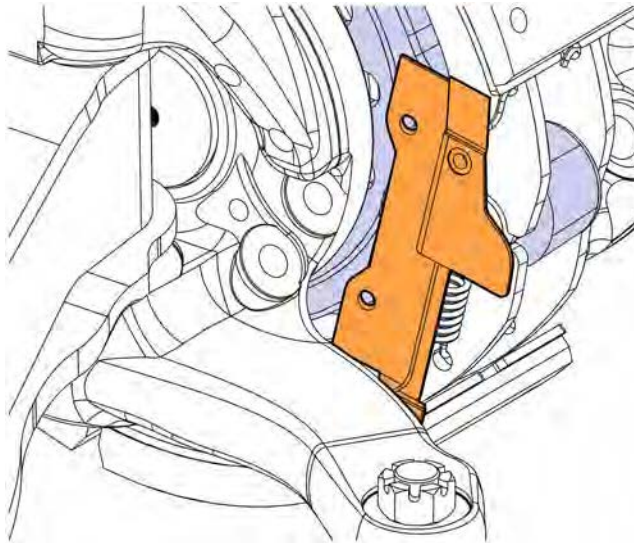
11 Install the replacement brake shoes, brake springs and rollers.

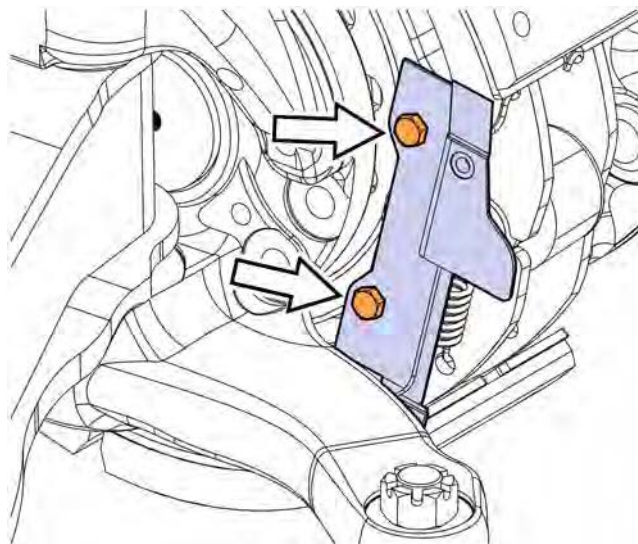
12 Install the new z-bracket. See the table on page 1 for the correct part numbers.

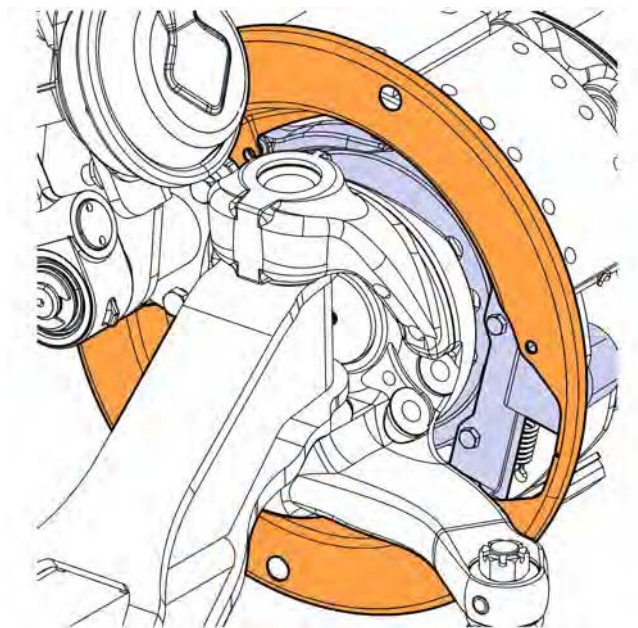
13 Install the fasteners securing the z-bracket. See the table on page 1 for the correct part numbers.

14 Tighten the fasteners to 40 ± 5 Nm (29 ± 3 ft-lb).



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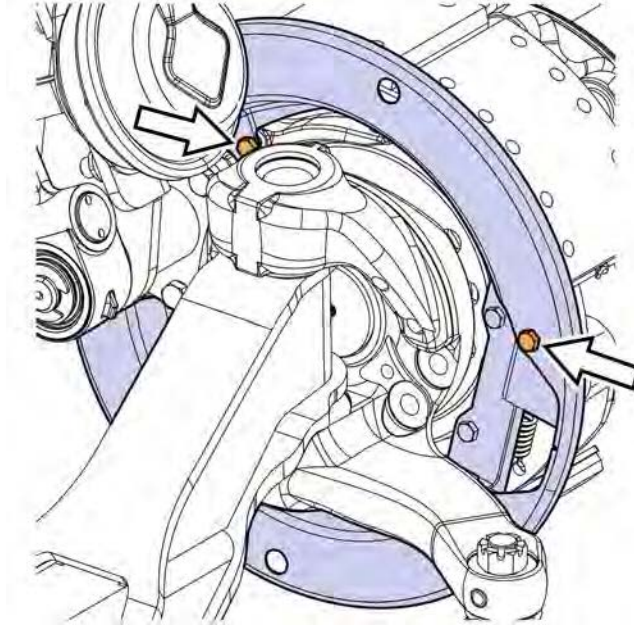
15 Install new dust shield. See the table on page 1 for the correct part numbers.

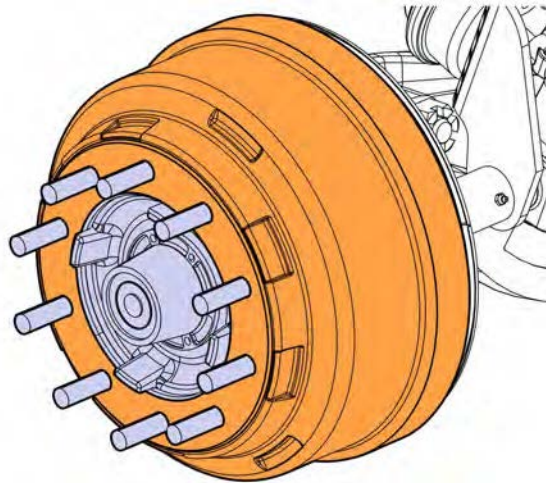
16 Install the four fasteners securing the dust shield.

17 Tighten dust shield fasteners to 40 ± 5 Nm (29 ± 3 ft-lb).



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18 Install the replacement brake drum (178 mm (7.0 in) wide). See the table on page 1 for the correct part numbers.



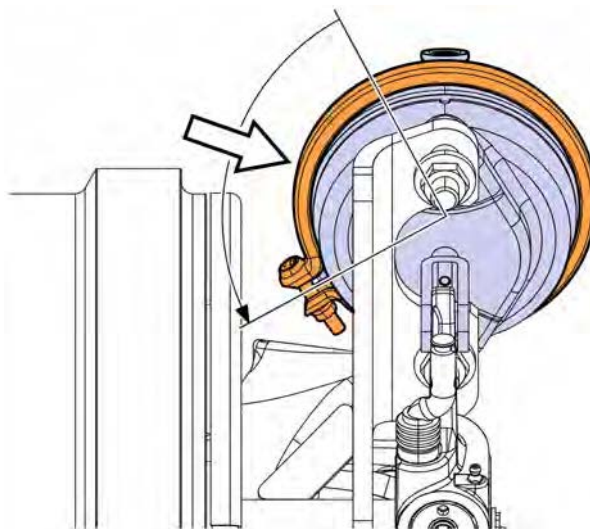
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19 If applicable, loosen the brake chamber clamp and re-position the clamp at a 45° angle or until proper clearance of the wheel is obtained. See figure below.

Note: Do not rotate the brake chamber. Rotate the clamp only.

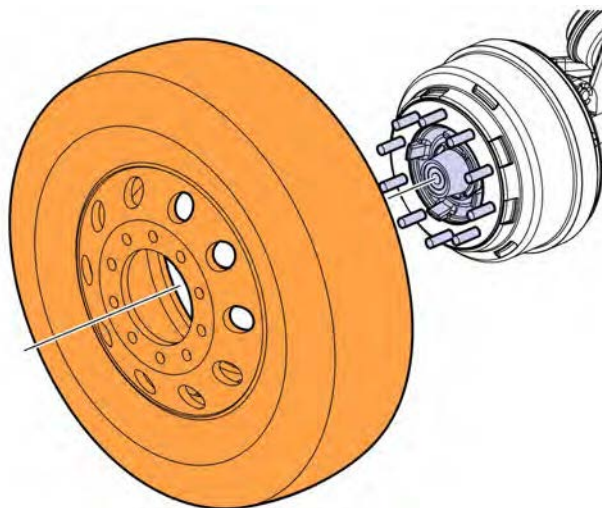
Note: Ensure the brake chamber clamp does not interfere with the dust shield or drum.

20 If applicable, tighten the brake chamber clamp fastener to 44 ± 4 Nm (32 ± 3 ft-lb).



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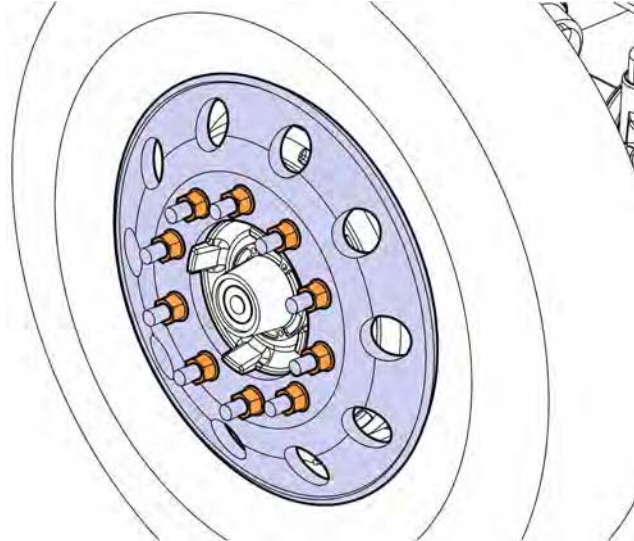
21 Install the wheel.



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22 Install the wheel nuts.

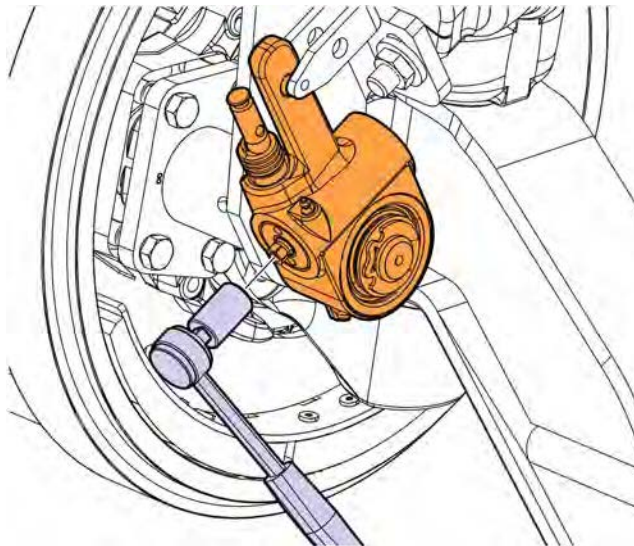
23 Tighten the wheel nuts to 610 Nm (450 ft-lb).



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24 Adjust the brake as recommended per (slack adjuster) manufacturer.

Note: The Gunite slack adjuster is shown in this procedure for adjusting the brake. However, this procedure is similar for other brands.



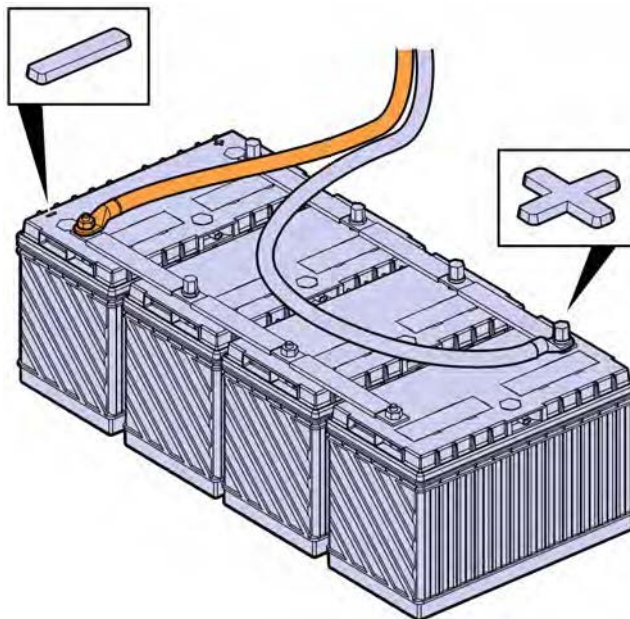

25 Repeat steps 1 through 24 for the left side of the truck.

- 26 Lift the steer axle with a jack, remove the jack stands, and lower the axle.
- 27 Go to Commissioning the Truck for Operation.

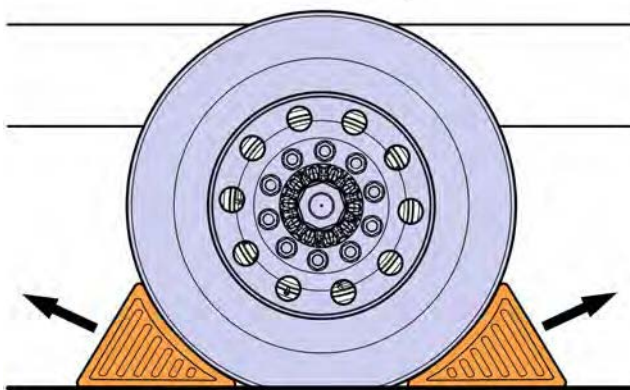
Commissioning the Truck for Operation

- 1 Connect the battery cable to the negative (ground) terminal.



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- 2 Remove the wheel chocks.
