

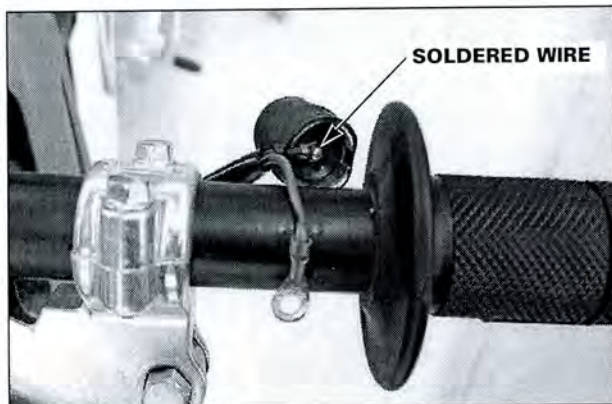

Faulty Engine Stop Button at Set-Up?

Not likely. Recently AHM has received warranty claims for "defective" engine stop buttons. But when the claimed buttons were inspected by AHM, they operate normally. Upon further investigation by District Service Managers, it was discovered that the engine stop buttons were installed with the contact plate in backwards. When installing the engine stop button on the medium displacement CRF-F models, make sure the contact plate is installed so that side with the soldered wire is facing the handlebar as shown. Then install the insulator and hold down straps. Lastly, test the engine stop button during the PDI process. If it doesn't work properly, check the contact plate orientation.



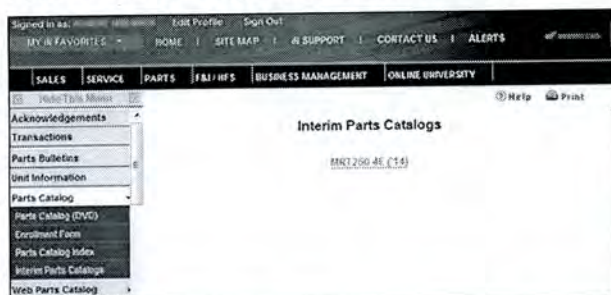

Available Special Tools

Due to the limited production of the MRT260 4E, the following special tools will not be auto-shipped to dealers, instead you must order them.

The above tools are available through normal parts ordering channels.

Special Transmission Oil

The Owner's Manual for MRT260 4E states to use ELF HTX740 transmission oil, which is now available through normal parts ordering channels. If the incorrect oil is used in the transmission, the customer may encounter clutch drag. Currently there is a limited quantity, so only order it if your customer requires it.

Wheel Stripe Installation at Set-Up

The Set-Up procedure for the Matte Black Metallic/Yellow CBR300R includes the installation of wheel stripes. Be sure to follow the instructions in the *SUI* and carefully apply the stripes before unit delivery.

Decal Installation Tips

After cleaning the wheel rim with rubbing alcohol, carefully spray the wheel rim with Pro Honda Glass Cleaner. Next, apply the decal to the wet surface and "float" it into the correct position. Once every thing is set, squeeze the liquid out from under the decal with your finger. After all the decals are firmly adhered to both wheels, peel the clear protective film off of each color stripe in the same order they were applied.

Use the Set-Up Instructions and Set-Up Notices

It has come to the attention of American Honda that some dealers are improperly setting up some new models. Starting with the *Set-Up Instructions*, Honda provides all the information necessary to properly un-crate, set-up, and pre-delivery

inspect every model in the line-up. If there is an area of set-up that requires particular emphasis, we may issue an *Important Set-Up Notice* on the Set-Up Instructions page of *iN* and, if necessary, call attention to the issue with an article in *The Wrench*.

It is imperative that the Service Management in your dealership take ownership of the Set-Up process by coordinating the distribution of relevant Set-Up materials to the correct staff or set-up company:

- Print and organize all *Set-Up Instructions*
- Post *Important Set-up Notices* in a prominent location of the set-up area
- Share articles in *The Wrench* with relevant staff members
- Inspect the Set-Up work and take corrective action as necessary
- Discuss the above points in your dealership's Service Department meetings
